BUILDING FEE (EUROS)

The Building Fee is a mandatory, **non-refundable** fee paid for the first five years a student is enrolled from Grades 1 through 12. It is used to support CAISL's capital and building expenses. **Parents of children in Early Childhood and Kindergarten may begin paying prior to entry into Grade 1. The request needs to be made in writing to the Accounts Office.**

REGISTRATION (EUROS)

The **Registration Fee** is a one-time, mandatory, and **non-refundable** fee for all students entering CAISL for the 1st time. It is **600.00€** per child.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PAYMENTS

All school fees are subject to revision during the school year in the event of unusual or unforeseen economic conditions.

The **First Quarter** fees (Tuition and Building Fee, if applicable) of attendance are owed as a condition of registering or re-registering and are not refundable under any circumstances. **Failure to pay 1st quarter by the due date results in the loss of your child's place and the invoice amounts are still due.**

DISCOUNTS ON YEARLY TUITION & BUILDING FEES

Early Payments

- 3% reduction on **Tuition** paid in full on or before June 15, 2026.
- 3% reduction on **Building fee** paid in full on or before June 15, 2026 together with yearly Tuition

Early payments to receive discounts will not be refunded under any circumstances.

The amount with discount owed on the invoice for annual payment is the one at the bottom of the invoice in the gray box. The full amount is shown above. If the full amount is paid rather than the discounted amount, CAISL will take this as evidence that the payer has decided to pay without the discount.

Sibling Discounts

- 15% reduction of the **Tuition & Building Fee** for a 3rd child enrolled concurrently at CAISL.
- 25% reduction of the **Tuition & Building Fee** for a 4th child (and any subsequent children) enrolled concurrently at CAISL.

Sibling discounts are applied to the youngest children.

RE-REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS (FROM POLICY 4.3025)

- Compliance with the Enrollment Contract;
- eligibility to re-enroll as per Policy 8.201;
- no outstanding debts to the school and no historic pattern of late payments;
- timely submission of form and payments and approval of payer entity if not the parents.

LATE ADMISSION

In the case of entry during the quarter, the fee to reserve the place is Tuition for the full quarter, as well as the Registration Fee and the full year's Building Fee (if applicable).

EARLY WITHDRAWAL

Written notification of intent to withdraw during the 2026-2027 school year must be given in writing to the Admissions Office by the following deadlines which are approximately one month before payments for the next quarter are due.

2nd Quarter: Oct 2, 2026 / 3rd Quarter: Dec 18, 2026 / 4th Quarter: Mar 25, 2027

Failure to provide written notice to the Admissions Office by the required deadline will result in the full quarter's fees being due. Any attendance in the quarter results in the full quarter's fees being due.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

A small number of fee reductions are granted annually to children in Grades 1 through 12 based on financial need. To be eligible, the child(ren) must have been enrolled at CAISL for at least one year and must maintain good academic and behavioral records. Families are required to provide documentation of the financial need and must be positive, supportive members of the CAISL community. CAISL will accept financial assistance applications until February 20, 2026. The Board of Trustees will review applications, and parents will be notified of the decision by the Director no later than April 1, 2026. Application forms are available on the school website. Lunch is now included in the fees for Early Childhood students. For students in Grades 1 and above, lunch service is optional and can be signed up for separately.

If lunch is purchased on a quarterly or annual basis, fees will be billed along with tuition invoices. Please note that lunch is not served on half-days.

Cancellation of Lunch Service must be done in writing to the Accounts Office and is only effective as of the following quarter.

For those who have paid for quarterly or yearly lunches, no adjustments are made for absences in the case of illness or other reasons except when the absence is a result of illness or school trip lasting 5 or more consecutive school days. Illness must be verified by a doctor's note. Service fees will also be adjusted if classes on campus are suspended by Government mandate.

Since Students in Grade 12 end classes earlier than other students, parents of Grade 12 Students may request an adjustment to the quarterly lunch fee, depending on their individual needs and schedules. Parents should contact the Accounts Manager no later than May 1, 2027 to request such an adjustment.

Elementary students who remain on campus without a scheduled activity or are not picked up on time after their activity will be directed to childcare. Any time spent in childcare will be considered a drop-in, and a **30 Euro daily fee** will apply unless the student is pre-registered for the childcare service. Sign-ups for this service take place at the same time as after-school activity selection. **Grades 3–5:** Students without a scheduled after-school activity will first attend **Homework Clinic (3:45 – 5:00 PM)** before being directed to childcare. Cancellation of ASCC must be done in writing to the Accounts Office and is only effective as of the following quarter.

Occasional ridership = 17.00€ one way

Morning pick-up on the regular route as coordinated with the school.
Afternoon: Leaves school at the end of classes (around 3:50 PM)

Available to all students.

Bus routes are organized based on ridership needs and not all requests may be accommodated.

The costs are charged per Route. All Routes are arranged by the school according to all students' addresses and distance from the school. Parents who have recurrent needs for pick up and/or drop off points in different routes need to pay the fee multiplied by the number of routes on which they require a reserved space.

Three (3) school days' advance notice is required to start or adjust a pick-up/drop-off point on the bus route should you change address or circumstances, such as days of after-school activities. Please give the Accounts Office no less than 3 school days' notice to enable a revision of the existing route and inform other riders of a change in schedule or time, should it be necessary. Cancellation of any of the various transportation services must be done in writing to the Accounts Office and is only effective as of the following quarter.

For those who have paid for quarterly buses, no adjustments are made for absences in the case of illness or other reasons except when the absence is a result of illness or a school trip lasting 5 or more consecutive school days. Illness must be verified by a doctor's note. Service fees will also be adjusted if classes on campus are suspended by Government mandate.

Since students in Grade 12 end classes earlier than other students, parents of Grade 12 students may request an adjustment to the quarter transportation fee, depending on their individual needs and schedules. Parents should contact the Accounts Manager no later than May 1, 2027 to request such an adjustment.

OTHER OPTIONAL COSTS

Field Trips

Costs for most field trips taken during the school day are included in tuition. Overnight trips and some day trips will require an extra fee. Any fees required will be communicated to parents in advance.

International Baccalaureate Diploma Fees

Additional fees are required to register for IB Diploma exams. Information on these fees can be obtained from the HS-IB Program Coordinator.

AFTER SCHOOL EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

CAISL offers a range of curricular support and extracurricular activities after school, for which there are no additional costs. Students may also be offered the opportunity to participate in additional, paid, activities provided by non-CAISL educators or organizations. For students in Secondary School (Grades 6 through 12), free transport is provided at 5:50 PM, when these activities are over.
