

## Concurrent Enrollment Form

This form **MUST** be signed off by the student's Counselor and Principal/Designee  
prior to student beginning the course

Credit(s) will not be awarded on your TUSD transcript if no prior approval is obtained

- This form is to be used for students who wish to take acceleration and/or remediation courses.
- Students must obtain prior approval from both their site Principal/Designee and Counselor.
- The costs associated with taking these courses will be the responsibility of the student, parent or guardian.
- Counselors may require parents/students to provide course descriptions from their chosen online provider.
- Students interested in making up credits during the summer may elect to enroll in approved online courses
- English, Social Science, Science and Fine Art courses are not allowable for acceleration.
- PE is only allowable for 10th grade, and only if a student has 6 academic/academy courses on their schedule.
- A maximum of 40 total credits are allowable, and only from BYU online, Silicon Valley, and/or UC Scout.
- Concurrent enrollment high school courses will not be counted toward Valedictorian or Valedictorian tie-break.
