- Tickets are for **GRADUATING POLY SENIORS ONLY**.
 - No Non-Grads Allowed - If you are NOT eligible to graduate & you purchase a ticket, NO REFUND will be given.
 - No Guests Allowed
- Tickets are **NON-REFUNDABLE and NON-TRANSFERRABLE. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN FOR ANY REASON..**

Grad Night Rules & Expectations

All students must arrive together with their school in buses. Arriving at Grad Bash in a student-driven vehicle is not permitted.

Each Attendee attending Grad Night is responsible for his/her own ticket throughout the duration of the visit. Tickets are non-refundable, non-transferable and will not be replaced if lost, damaged or stolen. Attendees may also receive an event wristband following successful completion of the security screening at the Grad Night screening location. Keep your WRISTBAND ON! This is the only way you will be allowed to stay in the park after it closes to the general public.



Grad Night Rules &

Expectations

Entertainment: Dress in *GOOD TASTE* (appropriate for a family gathering). All seniors who purchase a ticket will receive a Disney-themed Grad Night t-shirt.

Comfortable walking shoes. **Students are prohibited from wearing clothing with ANY REFERENCES TO DRUGS, ALCOHOL, or TOBACCO PRODUCTS.** A

sweatshirt or jacket is also recommended.

What to Bring:

- School ID/Minga ID
- Cell Phone & portable charger
- Debit/ATM Card/Credit Card /Cash accepted
- ***Drawstring backpacks are encouraged*** for this event. If you are bringing a purse, it must be smaller than 8.5" x 11' (paper size). No large bags/backpacks.
- No food or beverages, non-prescribed medication, liquids, gum, mints, etc. are allowed. All bags will be subject to search by RUSD staff, as well as Disney Resort staff and Anaheim Police Department



Senior Events, Senior Contracts, & The No-Go List

All Wednesday School, lunch detentions, and Saturday Schools must be cleared before you will be allowed to purchase tickets or attend any Senior Ticketed Events. Consequences MUST BE CLEARED AT LEAST SEVEN [7] DAYS BEFORE any Senior Event.

All Seniors MUST have a SIGNED SENIOR CONTRACT on file by WED. MARCH 11th.. You will not be allowed to purchase tickets, attend any Senior Ticketed Event, receive graduation tickets, & you may forfeit the opportunity to walk at graduation if your signed contract is not received on or before March 11th! .

Date: Tuesday, May 26th, 2026


Time: 8:30 - 11:00 AM

The Questionnaire will save your information, so if you cannot finish it today because you are awaiting information, you can start it and come back to it at a later date.




Senior Check-Out: To-Do List



Graduation Tickets


You will receive 8 FREE GRADUATION TICKETS at the end of the SECOND graduation practice at King HS.
