- 2. K/1 Assessments: should be completed before a student turns 6**

Complete file reviews if a student has not demonstrated significant change or is not changing placement. This needs to be marked as a “Re-evaluation” in SEIS even though it is a file review. Dates will line up with the K/1 file review.

Complete full re-assessment if student demonstrates significant change or needs a possible change of placement.

- If you assess a student in January consider it an Initial with combined K/1
- If you completed a late initial (ex: November or December, ect.) you would hold a file review as the K/1 and still mark it as a “Re-evaluation” in Seis.
- Reset the dates to match up with the K/1 file review for the next Triennial

- 4. State Preschool Assessments**

-Home school will complete the initial state preschool assessment if the student has already turned 4 years old.

If the student is enrolled at a preschool or state preschool at a TUSD school site, the SLP at that site will provide the services.

If the student is not enrolled and attends a daycare or is at home, the SLP from the home school site with schedule drop-in services

5. Funds outside of Amazon

7. Advocate Cases:

- Present Levels should reflect all of the information in your old and current goal levels
- Baselines should match how the goal is written. If your goal says in “4 out of 5 trials”, your baseline should read in “Johnny is able to _____ in 1 out of 5 trials”
- Advocates like clean baselines
- Continue the goals that were only met with 50% accuracy. Baseline would match your Annual review comment. “Student did not meet this goal, he/she is able to do this with 48% accuracy”. This is now your baseline on the goal you are continuing.
