DIPLOMA PATHS:

TOPS TECH

- 2 year college or technical program
 - *Still have the opportunity to attend a 4 year college as a transfer student*
- 23 credits required
 - 4 English, 4 Math
 - 2 Social Studies, 2 Science
 - 1.5 PE and .5 Health OR 2 JROTC
 - 9 Career electives
- No Foreign Language requirement
- No Fine Arts requirement
- Industry Based Certification required

TOPS UNIVERSITY

- 4 year college
- 24 credits
 - 4 English, 4 Math
 - 4 Social Studies, 4 Science
 - 1.5 PE and .5 Health OR 2 JROTC
 - 3 electives
 - 1 Fine Arts
 - 2 Foreign Language
- Industry Based Certification optional

***Decision is made Sophomore year*

ACADEMIC LEVELS

On-Level

- Majority of students
- College prep curriculum

Resource

- Must have an IEP with an exceptionality
- Smaller setting
- More support

*Honors

- Increased rigor
- Faster pace
- Creates strong foundation for DE and AP courses

*Gifted

- Must have a Gifted IEP
- Most rigorous
- Smaller setting
- Pupil appraisal screening to determine gifted placement

**For Honors and Gifted,
students can choose to take 1 course or all 4 core.*

DUAL ENROLLMENT / ADVANCED PLACEMENT

DE

- Not available for freshmen
- Freshmen taking a 1st year language in 8th grade are encouraged to wait until sophomore year to take 2nd year DE option
- Courses taken through local universities
- Credit awarded by passing the course

AP

- Not available for freshmen
- Credit awarded by scoring a 3 or better on the AP exam (University discretion)

TALENTED PROGRAMS

- Art, Music, and Theatre
- Must have a Talented IEP to participate in these programs
- Different than Junior High
 - Scheduled as an elective, not a pullout/enrichment
- Counts as the student's Fine Arts credit
- For students interested in these programs, auditions are held twice a year.
 - Normally in September and November
 - 2 step process: Student must pass a school audition as well as a state audition
