1.0 Welcome & Roll Call

- 1.1 PROCEDURES & TEAM NORMS. Reminders of public comment procedures, and review of the scope of the Team's advisory authority. **Mrs. Lucero called the meeting to order at 3:55 pm after a few technical glitches with getting our SOT team onto our Google meet link.**

2.0 New Items

- 2.1 2020-2021 Budget updates: **This is an update from what came out from the legislative session this summer. NV State was going to cut Learning Strategists positions statewide and SB 178 money used for our CTT position. Mrs. Lucero learned last week that those cuts will not be made. We will be losing 125 dollars per student for funding. We were projected to have 588 enrollment but we are short 55 students at this time. We may get some more enrollments but probably not 55 by count day.**

- 2.2 Class sizes, programs, upcoming budget information: **Kindergarten was the only grade level that came in solid with numbers of enrollments. 1st - 5th grade class are all below projections. We will discuss more next month when we get our actual Betsy Rhodes Budget for 2020-2021.**
- 2.3 Distance Education discussion- **Discussion was all about the different needs of what parents are struggling with during distance education, especially with younger students learning devices. We discussed how to brainstorm more ways to keep students engaged through the entire instructional day. FACES has created videos to help families struggling with learning how to teach at home.**
- 2.4 SOT Team election information for 2020-2021: **We will be working with PTA in September for parent nominations for the new parent members of SOT. Teachers and Support Staff will also be having SOT elections mid September.**
