- 2.1 Hybrid Celebrations and Information - Teachers worked hard to prepare for students in less time than usual, while still teaching and supporting students to the full extent. Parent feedback - smooth transition back to school schedule and being on campus; students are so happy to be back on campus (rocket arms); arrival and dismissal has been very smooth, with proper spacing and distance; good spacing items for hallways and guidance for students
- 2.2 Reopening- April 6th Information - remind parents about utilizing crossing guards for safety purposes and setting a good example for all students and families; information/reminders about school zones & what tickets and violations can happen; positive incentives (from sappington?) from crossing guards for using the crosswalks versus jaywalking;
 - 2.2.1 **NEEDS - individual items (tissue packs, sanitizer?; wellness bags for activities; ziploc bags)**
 - 2.2.2 - Distance/Blended learning options for next school year - 25 schools will be chosen to get it started; options for schools to volunteer to pilot an online version of the school year for next year; possible community feedback sessions may happen for questions/comments about potential for online school work
- 2.3 Security door/ other budget spending items for 2020-2021- security door is tucked back further & office cannot see down the hallway to control who is entering. MPR & Health office are accessible without the locked security door; \$26,000/38,000 for installation of security door; complete the project over the summer
