Possible uses for the other \$100,000: paying for a couple extra hours for support staff to work an extra hour during the day, changing the school aide position to a instructional aide position, looking to give support staff an extra \$500 each so their retention bonus is the same as licensed staff, possibly getting a poster maker for the school about \$10,000, possibly looking at getting a buzzer for the front office door, maybe looking at upgrading cameras.**
