2.1 Panorama Results

- Challenging Feelings - 49% favorable
- Emotional Regulation - 39% favorable
- Positive Feelings - 69% favorable (up 2% from previous year)
- Raise Your Hand - 75% favorable (down 3% from previous year)
- Sense of Belonging - 62% favorable (down 2% from previous year)
- Social Awareness - 63% favorable (down 4% from previous year)
- Supportive Relationships - 88% favorable (up 1% from previous year)

2.2 Continuous Improvement Plan

- Student Success
 - School Goal - Increase the percentage of students proficient on the Math SBAC from 41.4% to 46.4% - supported by vertical alignment and collaboration amongst grade level teams and consistent unwrapping of grade level standards. SBAC math interim assessments will be implemented.
 - action steps: math tutoring, SDD, unwrapping standards, interim implementation
- Adult learning culture
 - School Goal: 4% of teachers are implementing Tier 1 PBIS tier 1 structures through a positive to negative ratio of at least 5:1, based on walkthrough data. By end of year, at least 75% of staff will implement a positive to negative ratio of 5:1
 - Action steps: PBIS walkthroughs, professional learning
- Connectedness
 - School Goal: Increase percentage of parents who agree or strongly agree that “they know what goes on inside my child’s school from 87% to 92% by 2023.
 - Action steps: PTA meetings, family nights, community events, message from the principal, parent volunteer opportunities, Pastries with the principal
