A-C Valley Update: Weather-Related Cancellations: February 4, 2026

A-C Valley Parents, Staff, and Students,

The administrative team is sharing this information with our community to provide guidance on snow days and future cancellations at the school district. The 2025-2026 school calendar has three built-in snow make-up days, three remote learning days, and if needed, all other snow days will be added to the end of the school calendar.

We have used two of the three built-in snow days, which will be made up on March 13 and 16, 2026. At this time, we have one more snow make-up day remaining, and if needed, the next snow day will be made up on April 2, 2026. Then we will move to remote learning:

On a Remote Learning Day, elementary students will complete learning at home using the Remote Learning Packet(s) provided in a white folder. Students have received three days of packets, and only one packet should be completed per Remote Learning Day. This packet should be returned to school when students return for regular instruction. Attendance will be marked present once the completed packet is turned in. Every classroom teacher will make contact via Class Dojo on Remote Learning Days with specific information regarding special classes, teacher contact information, office hours, and other necessary information.

A Remote Learning day at the Jr/Sr HS begins with all students logging into their Google Classroom, starting on the 2-hour delay schedule. This is an attendance requirement and includes students enrolled in a study hall during first period. Teachers will provide some form of remedial work for students to complete. All students must submit their Remote Learning assignment within 24 hours of the class. Teachers' main role is to support students as they complete the assignment of the day. Students lacking online access will need to contact the school or office immediately to solve these issues.

We recognize that all of our families' circumstances are different and that you may have difficulties related to transportation, work schedules, childcare, or road conditions. Please remember that when making decisions about school operations, parents and guardians still have the right to keep your children home due to weather concerns. We are hopeful that the blend of built-in snow days and remote learning days will accommodate many of our families through this very difficult winter season.

If you have questions or concerns about Remote Learning Days, please reach out to the principals at each school. They will provide you with detailed information about the expectations for teachers and students during remote learning days. If you have questions about delays or cancellations, contact the superintendent's office at 724-659-5820.

Thank you for your continued support and flexibility as we work together to ensure learning continues.
