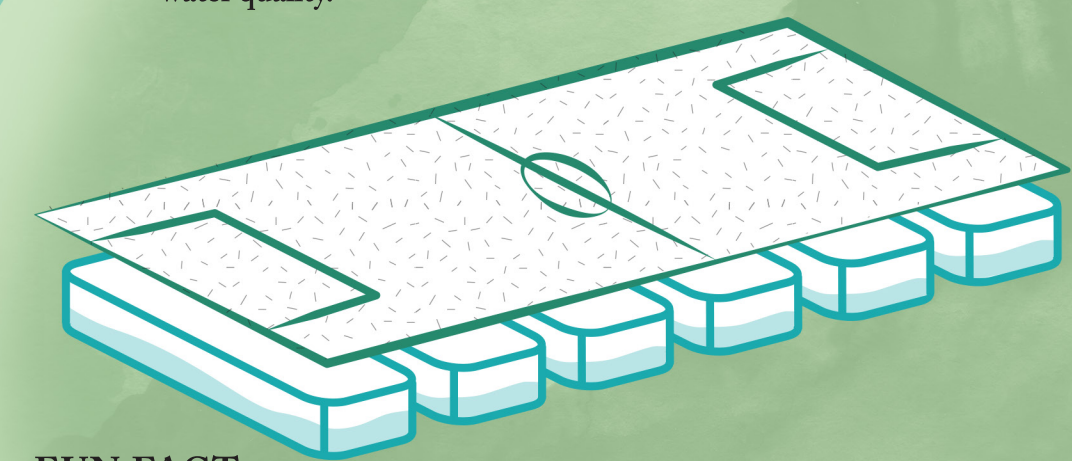

## NATURE TRAIL

The campus of Friends School is a teaching landscape for the 21st century, modeling ecological stewardship for students, families, and the larger community. It features pocket habitats characteristic of the region, from oak woods to meadow outcrops to rocky hillsides.



Vegetation, whether planted or naturally occurring, plays many important roles, providing habitat for birds and insects, preventing runoff into nearby Stony Run, filtering air, cooling buildings and outdoor spaces, inspiring daily study, and creating beauty and enjoyment for all.
