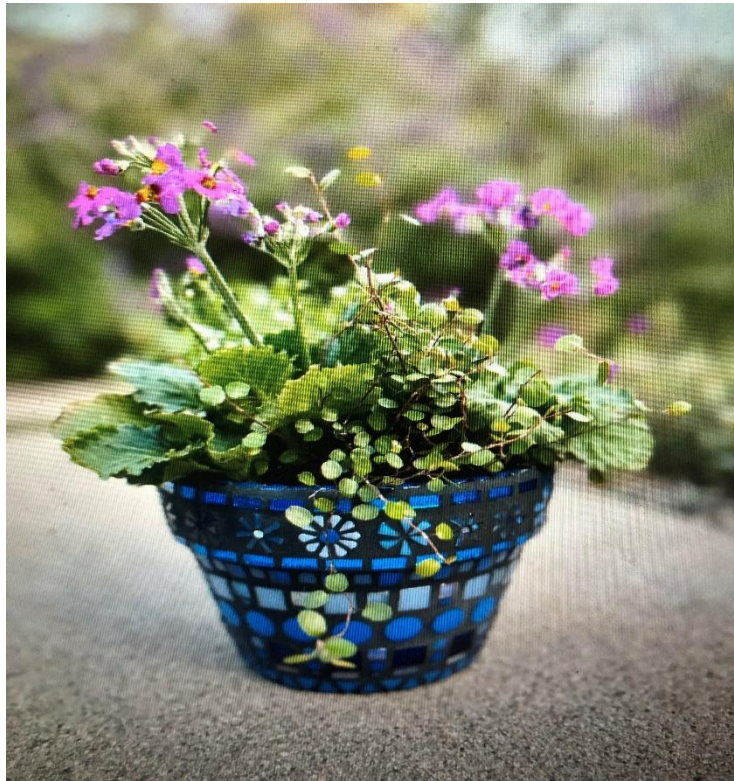
Get Creative

CPR Training

Monday, March 30, 6:30 – 9:30 p.m.

Evergreen Park Fire Department, 9000 South Kedzie. Park in the North or West Parking Lot and enter through the first door on the West side of the building.

CPR, or cardio-pulmonary resuscitation, is an important skill that everyone should learn. You will never know when you may need this skill to save a loved one. Take the time to get certified and enjoy the peace of mind of knowing you can help someone in need.

The Heartsaver CPR class (not CPR for healthcare workers) will be provided to you by an American Heart Association certified instructor from the **Evergreen Park Fire Department**. Upon completion you will receive a Heartsaver Completion Card that is valid for 2 years. Individuals registering must be at least 13 years of age or older.

A \$25.00 non-refundable deposit (check made out to Evergreen Park Fire Department) is required when registering. (Please note: There is no charge for EP Village Employees, however you must complete the registration process.) This deposit is used to pay for the CPR card you will receive verifying that you have taken the class and are certified in CPR.

Maximum class size 10 people. Registrations will be handled on a first-come basis.
