

JTHS Alumni Reunion Venues

Joliet & Surrounding Area

Joliet Township High School alumni have many local options for class reunions, from casual gatherings to formal milestone celebrations. Class committees are encouraged to consider class size, budget, accessibility, and desired atmosphere when selecting a venue.

Larger classes (about 75–200+ guests)

- Jacob Henry Mansion – Historic mansion and banquet space with on-site parking; ideal for more formal reunions (Joliet).
- Renaissance Center – Flexible downtown event center with multiple room sizes (Joliet).
- The Haley Mansion – High-end event venue with standout ambiance for 25th, 40th, or 50th reunions (Joliet).
- Rialto Square Theatre – Historic downtown theater with event spaces that work well for large, formal reunion events (Joliet).
- The Grand Ballroom at Joliet Union Station – Grand historic ballroom in a central downtown location (Joliet).
- Niko’s Banquet – Dedicated banquet hall suitable for dinner/dance-style reunions (Joliet).
- Mansard Room Inc – Banquet Hall with cocktail-bar atmosphere, used for dinners and dances (Rockdale).
- Heroes West (Joliet) – Sports-bar restaurant with banquet rooms that can be combined for larger groups (Joliet).
- 176 West Banquet Hall – Banquet/event space suited for mid-size class dinners and social gatherings.
- Joliet Area Historical Museum – Downtown Museum with rental spaces that can host receptions and social events in a unique, historic setting (Joliet).

Medium classes (about 40–100 guests)

- Juliet’s Tavern – Historic downtown tavern with upstairs private event spaces and a downtown Joliet
- Jameson’s Pub – Restaurant with group-friendly dining, suitable for smaller reunion dinners or planning meetings.
- 176 West Banquet Hall – Banquet/event space suited for mid-size class dinners and social gatherings.
- Al’s Steak House – Family-friendly steakhouse with banquet facilities.

- Heroes West banquet rooms – Flexible configurations for mid-size classes with buffet and bar package
- The Crystal Room – Downtown banquet hall with ADA accessibility and parking; works well for mid-size events like class dinners or anniversaries.
- Cemeno’s Pizza – Casual Joliet favorite with party rooms that work well for laid-back reunion dinners or mid-size class gatherings.
- Smaller rooms at Renaissance Center

Smaller gatherings (under 40 guests)

- Al’s Steak House – Family-friendly steakhouse with banquet facilities for 15–150 guests, suitable for smaller reunion dinners.
- Merichka’s Restaurant – Local landmark with a private dining room and casual atmosphere (Crest Hill).
- Cemeno’s Pizza – Private or semi-private areas for small groups, ideal for informal planning meetings or casual mini-reunions.
- Juliet’s Tavern smaller spaces – Works well for intimate class dinners or planning meetings.

Tips for reunion planners

- Book early, especially for peak months (June–October) and milestone reunion years; many venues offer customized menus and bar packages.
- Ask about AV support, dance floor space, and accessibility (entrances, restrooms, parking) to ensure a comfortable experience for all classmates.
