Facility Use Process – Frequently Asked Questions

Why did the District change the facility use process?

To ensure student safety, provide fair and consistent access to facilities, and better manage staffing, scheduling, and operational costs. This helps keep school and student activities the top priority.

Does this mean community groups can no longer use school facilities?

No. Community use remains important to the Rainier School District. The updated process simply creates clearer expectations and consistency for everyone.

Why do I need to complete a Facility Use Request Form now?

The form helps the District confirm space availability, staffing needs, supervision requirements, and any associated costs. It ensures requests are handled fairly and safely.

Are there fees to use district facilities?

Some uses may require fees based on the type of activity, staffing needs, and facility use. Fees are applied consistently and help offset operational costs.

Do Rainier students and school programs get priority?

Yes. Activities directly connected to Rainier students and school programs receive priority scheduling.
