WHO: GHC SENIORS ONLY (NO GUESTS)

WHAT: A ONCE-IN-A-LIFETIME GRAD NITE PARTY for the **CLASS OF 2026**

WHERE: **DISNEYLAND & CALIFORNIA ADVENTURE** - Anaheim, California.
Your ticket includes round trip luxury bus transportation, a Park Hopper pass to Disneyland and California Adventure, unlimited use of attractions, and a private California Adventure Dance Party just for seniors!

WHEN: **WEDNESDAY, JUNE 3, 2026** (buses begin loading around 10:00 a.m.; first bus expected to depart around 10:30, and last bus expected to depart around 11:45)

COST: \$300 for PTSA members; \$320 for non-members

SALES: Friday, Feb. 20, Mon. 2/23, Tues., 2/24, Thurs., 2/26, Fri., 2/27, Mon., 3/2, and Tues. 3/3, at lunch and during Periods 5 and 6 (only for students without Period 5 or 6 classes). Tickets will be sold at the home (south) concessions stand at the football stadium. Ticket quantities are limited. **NO sales on Wednesday, 2/25.**

HOW: Transportation from GHC to and from Disneyland will be by **BUS ONLY**.
To get on a bus, all students must show their **GHC I.D. and Boarding Pass, and must be on our list.** Buses will return to school at approximately 3:30 a.m. Thurs. morning, June 4. You must arrange your own ride to and from school. It is highly recommended that students do not drive themselves to and from GHC.

IMPORTANT – To purchase a ticket, each senior must have:

1. Current GHC I.D. (physical ID or Minga).
2. A completed and signed trip slip
3. Payment of \$300 (PTSA members)/\$320 (non-members) -- Cash or Credit/Debit Card/Apple/Google Pay.
4. Proof of PTSA membership for the discounted price. If student is not already a member, but would like to join, the total amount due is \$310 (\$300 discounted Grad Nite price plus \$10 PTSA membership).

If you wish to sit on a bus with your friends, your group **must** buy **all** the tickets at the same time, as tickets are sold by bus number. Upon arriving at the ticket window, **please let the seller know how many tickets you are buying as a group to ensure you are on the same bus.** If a bus has fewer seats available than you need, we can then open the next bus for your group. Students are assigned to a particular bus, but there are no assigned seats on the bus.

You **MUST** comply with any COVID rules in force at the time of Grad Nite, as set forth on Disneyland's website or as may be set by the school or PTSA.

NOTE: Tickets to Grad Nite were **NOT** sold in any senior package or at any time previously. Disneyland Magic Key passes cannot be used for this special event.

**BOARDING PASSES ARE NON-TRANSFERABLE (You may not sell or give away your pass)
You will receive your actual Grad Nite ticket as you exit the bus at Disneyland.**

GRAD NITE 2026 FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. **How much are tickets?** The cost is \$300 for PTSA members, or \$320 for non-members. For students who are already PTSA members, a copy of their membership card **MUST** be attached to the Trip Slip. If a non-member wants to join the PTSA, total cost will be \$310 (\$300 + \$10 membership). Cash or credit/debit cards accepted.
2. **When do we leave for Disneyland?** Buses will begin loading around 10:00 a.m. and depart GHC between approximately 10:30 and 11:45 am. Buses do **NOT** depart in numerical order. Line up with the group that matches your boarding ticket bus number. There is no assigned seating on the bus and no switching buses. Buses will return Thursday morning at approximately 3:30 a.m.
3. **Why do I need a trip slip?** Legally, the PTSA needs a trip slip from every person in case of any injuries or emergencies that may occur. No Trip Slip, no Grad Nite ticket!
4. **What if I'm 18?** You will sign your own trip slip instead of having your parent/guardian sign it.
5. **Do I need to bring my I.D.?** YES, you will need it when buying your Grad Nite ticket AND for getting on the bus the day of Grad Nite. To board the bus, photo ID (student ID or driver's license) is required.
6. **When is the last day to buy tickets?** Tickets will be sold February 20 through March 3, except Feb. 25. If any tickets are available after that, they will continue to be sold that week. Tickets are limited so buy by Mar. 3.
7. **What can I bring with me?** Disney will do a search at the gate prior to entering to check for any items not allowed in the park. You **MAY** bring cell phones, cameras, jackets, sunscreen, etc. If you bring items **NOT** allowed by Disney, you may be denied entry or required to discard the item. This includes selfie-sticks, loudspeakers, weapons, glass containers, tobacco, vapes, laser pointers and more. Please do not bring large backpacks. You may also rent lockers at the park, but they can go fast. Spending money for meals and souvenirs is recommended. Meals are **NOT** included in your ticket price. Outside food and beverages might not be allowed in the park, and no open food or drinks will be allowed on the bus. You may bring an **EMPTY** metal or plastic water bottle that can be refilled in the park. The contraband K-9s will inspect all belongings before boarding the bus. If you have any contraband, you will **NOT** be allowed to go, and there are **NO** refunds.
8. **What if I have medicine I need to take?** Personal medications are allowed, but **MUST** be in their original, labeled container and **MUST** be listed on your trip slip when purchasing your ticket. Even if you intend to bring something like Advil or Tylenol, list it on the slip. If you don't need it, leave it at home.
9. **When do I get my actual ticket to Disneyland?** As you exit the bus, each person will be given their park hopper pass. When you get your ticket, immediately place it in a safe place (you can also load it into the Disneyland app). You need it each time you park hop. Please do not lose your ticket or wristband.
10. **Can I buy tickets from someone else?** NO. The tickets must be GRAD NITE tickets and must be purchased from the PTSA. The name on the current GHC I.D. must match the person on the trip slip and boarding pass. We check this as you board the bus. Disneyland Magic Key passes cannot be used for this event.
11. **Do school rules apply at Disneyland?** YES!! This is a PTSA event and the same rules apply and will be enforced. There are also a lot of undercover officers and you will be arrested if you are caught doing anything illegal. If you appear under the influence as you get on the bus, or are suspected of having illegal substances, we will call school staff and they will evaluate the situation and determine if you will be permitted to board the bus. Don't ruin your Grad Nite by doing something foolish.
12. **Can I just drive to Disneyland and meet everyone there?** NO. Disneyland requires that attendees arrive via school-provided transportation. If you do not travel on one of our buses, you will not be given your ticket to enter. Special wristbands are given to each person at Disneyland after you pass through the security check and without that, you cannot get into Disneyland.
13. **What if I have only a few detentions I didn't get around to working off?** Simply put - **YOU DO NOT GO** and there are **NO REFUNDS**. We make it clear on all our forms and in announcements that everyone must have zero detention hours and zero money owed to the school or **YOU DO NOT GO!** Also, if for any reason the school says you are not allowed to attend Grad Nite, we will not let you board the bus and you will **not** receive a refund.
14. **What are the rules and dress code for Grad Nite?** Remember this is a family park and the general public will be there throughout the day. We want you to have fun, but we also want you to represent the Class of 2026 and GHC in a positive way. 15. **If I change my mind about going to Grad Nite, can I get a refund?** There are absolutely no refunds for Grad Nite tickets as these tickets are purchased in advance and Disneyland does not give refunds. But if you contact us ASAP, we may be able to facilitate a transfer to someone else who wants to go but does not have a ticket. ONLY ticket transfers done through the PTSA will be accepted and valid. If you buy/sell a ticket on your own, it will **NOT** be accepted.

NOTE: If you get sick on the bus due to drinking or drugs, you will be assessed a cleaning charge by the bus company.
