

1990-91 Girls Soccer Team



In the fall 1990, the Bayonne High School girls soccer team achieved one of the most significant accomplishments in the program's history by earning the New Jersey Group IV co-championship. Competing in the state's largest school division, Bayonne emerged as a top team and ultimately shared the Group IV state title with East Brunswick High School. This achievement highlighted the team's strong performance throughout the season and cemented 1990 as a landmark year for Bayonne girls soccer, reflecting the skill, dedication, and competitiveness of the players and coaching staff. This title remains the only state championship in the program's history. The state final ended in a 1-1 tie, resulting in the co-championship. Tara Kobelski scored the game-tying goal for Bayonne in the second half. Bayonne finished the 1990 season with an overall record of 16-1-1 and was ranked #4 in the nation!
