

## Coach William “Bill” Broderick



William “Billy” Broderick was a legendary coach at Bayonne High School whose outstanding career few can rival. Bill’s coaching career spanned over four decades. The man who initiated the Girls Tennis program led the Bees to four Hudson County Championships and an overall record of 201-50. Coach led the boys to 21 County Championships and at one point had a 69 match win streak against County competition. Bill’s Boys’ team was the only Hudson County team to ever win 32 matches in a single season. His boys reached 20 consecutive Hudson County finals from 1993-2012. He was named Coach of the Year 21 times and led the Boys to an overall record of 732-169. Thanks to his dedication and work effort, Coach was inducted into the New Jersey Scholastic coaches Hall of Fame and was named the Star-Ledger Boys Tennis Coach of the Year in 1998. In 2003, he received the National Federation of High Schools Men’s Tennis National Coach of the Year Award and was inducted into the Hudson County Sports Hall of Fame in 2004.
