

# Stanley Gutt

## Class of 1988



Stan Gutt is a legendary ice hockey figure best known for setting a long-standing state scoring record and his subsequent induction into multiple Halls of Fame. A 1988 graduate, Gutt was a three-sport All-County athlete (hockey, soccer, baseball). During his senior hockey season, he set the New Jersey state record for goals in a single season with 79, a record that still stands. In 1989, Bayonne High School retired his jersey, #27. He played Junior "A" hockey in Canada for the Pembroke Lumber Kings and Dauphin Kings. He then played at SUNY Potsdam, where he was the 1990-91 SUNYAC Rookie of the Year, and finished his collegiate career at SUNY Fredonia. For his achievements he was inducted into the Bayonne High School Hall of Fame and New Jersey High School Ice Hockey Hall of Fame.
