As Lent approaches, I find myself thinking not only about prayer, fasting, and sacrifice but also about community. Lent is a season that reminds us not to walk our faith journey alone. At OLGC Parish, we are blessed with a faith family that supports one another, prays for one another, and grows together. Sometimes, the simplest way to remember that is by gathering around a table.



Our annual Lenten Fish Fry has become one of those special moments in the life of our parish where faith feels real and familiar. Yes, we come for a good meal, but what keeps us coming back year after year is the fellowship. It's the conversations that begin easily, the smiles exchanged with people we may only see on Sundays, and the sense that for a couple of hours, we truly belong to something bigger than ourselves.

One of the most beautiful parts of the Fish Fry is seeing the children. Their joy and happiness fill our campus with life. Whether they are running to greet their friends, proudly carrying their trays, or laughing around the tables, their presence reminds us what parish life is truly about. They bring energy, innocence, and hope and they show us that our parish is not just alive but growing.

There is something deeply human and deeply Catholic about sharing a meal. Jesus did it constantly. He taught at tables, listened at tables, and built relationships at tables. In a busy world where we often rush from one obligation to the next, the Fish Fry gives us permission to slow down and simply be present with one another.

For families, it becomes a tradition. For longtime parishioners, it's a joyful reunion. For those who are new to OLGC, it can be the first real experience of feeling at home in our parish. It is one of the most natural ways we live out hospitality, welcoming others not with programs or speeches, but with warmth, conversation, and a seat at the table.

The Lenten Fish Fry is also a quiet form of prayer. In choosing to come together, to support OLGC, and to share in fellowship, we are practicing what Lent calls us to do: to turn outward, to build relationships, and to remember that faith grows best in community.

So, whether you come every year or have never attended before, consider this your personal invitation. Come hungry—not just for good food, but for connection. Bring your family, invite a friend, and come experience the joy of being together.

At OLGC Parish, our tables and our hearts are always open.


PATHWAYS TO PEACE: REFLECTIONS FROM SPIRITUAL MASTERS




