

The Staff Sergeant (SSGT) Jeremy Redding Legacy Award Criteria

Who is Eligible and What is the Amount of the Scholarship?

- Incoming/Returning 9th through 12th grade sons, daughters, grandsons, and granddaughters of active-duty U.S. military service members and/or honorably discharged veterans desiring to attend Delone Catholic High School
- \$2,500.00 scholarship payable directly to Delone Catholic High School, accompanied by a recognition award.

How Do I Apply?

- Complete and submit application.
- Submit an announcement (pamphlet, brochure, or poster) titled “Post Traumatic Stress – The Invisible Wound.”
- Submit an essay, based on your research and in your words what you learned about PTS, what “22 a day” means to you, and how you could make an impact by raising awareness.
- Included shall be two letters of recommendation (Sealed Envelope)
- Submissions shall be mailed to The Jeremy Redding Legacy Award, 51 Michelle Way, Hanover, PA 17331

Who selects the recipient?

- SSGT Jeremy Redding Memorial Foundation Board Member/Officers
- Delone Catholic administration/faculty, if applicable.
- Elementary administration/faculty (if applicant is currently in 8th grade), if applicable.

How Will Applicants be selected?

- **Awareness Pamphlet/Brochure/Poster – Does it appear professional?**
 - Is the information factual and accurate?
 - Does your research address causes, symptoms, and treatment options of PTS?
 - Can this be used to raise awareness if displayed publicly?
- **Research/Essay – Demonstrate you have researched PTS - what it means to you and what you have done or can do to raise awareness.**
 - The applicant shall write an essay based on their research (no more than 1,000 words) on what they learned about veteran PTS, what “22 a day” means to you, and how you could make an impact by raising awareness.

How Will the Award be administered?

- Presentation of the award will be held at The Jeremy Redding Memorial Ride held the Sunday before Memorial Day. The award will be presented by Delainey Robertson in conjunction with a member of the Jeremy Redding family.

Letters of Recommendation

Please include two letters of recommendation from non-family members. These letters must be received in a sealed envelope. Letters of recommendation should focus on the applicant's eligibility based on the criteria listed above in relation to the values.

The Staff Sergeant Jeremy Redding Legacy Award is a one-year scholarship. Previous recipients who have demonstrated continuous efforts to raise awareness and educate others with regards to post traumatic stress and veteran suicide may reapply; however, preference will be given to new applicants.
