TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR THE PROVISION OF INSTRUMENTAL LESSONS

1. The instrumental teacher will use their best endeavours to schedule thirty lessons for each pupil over the course of an academic year (from September to the following July). Any additional lessons will be scheduled after agreement with parents.
2. No more than ten lessons will be invoiced in respect of any one term except by prior agreement between the parent/guardian and teacher. Where more than ten lessons are actually taught in a term (e.g. during the long autumn term), the surplus lessons will be carried over and invoiced in the subsequent term.
3. Stonar's peripatetic teachers are self-employed and will invoice you directly. Payment due to them should be made to the payment details given on their invoice, and not to School. Payment is due in advance at the start of each term.
4. Lessons will still be charged if the pupil is absent.
5. Any lesson(s) charged for but not actually taught by the teacher during the relevant term due to the teacher's absence will be credited on the following term's invoice.
6. Any music, reeds or other sundries supplied by the teacher to the pupil during the course of a term will be invoiced in arrears on the following term's School account.
7. A term's notice in writing is required to discontinue tuition. A term's fees will be payable in lieu of notice.
8. Each May, parents/guardians will be notified of the rate of tuition fees chargeable for lessons during the academic year starting the following September.

FURTHER INFORMATION ON MUSIC LESSONS

It is normally possible to begin lessons at the beginning of each term and we endeavour to support pupils in connecting with a suitable teacher in time to do this. However, it is occasionally necessary to put a pupil onto a waiting list, depending on the instrument they wish to learn and the availability of the teacher. In this situation, we will write to you to let you know it has been necessary to do this and inform you when lessons are likely to begin.

Instrumental tuition at Stonar usually happens on a weekly basis, with pupils in Years 1-9 working to a rotating timetable wherever possible in order to ensure that any school lessons they miss due to instrumental tuition do not occur too frequently. Fixed lesson times are normally reserved for pupils in Years 10 - 13 who are studying for GCSE and A Level examinations, although it is sometimes possible to arrange a fixed time at the pupil's and teacher's convenience at another point in the school day.

Your son/daughter's teacher will be happy to discuss progress and any other matters should you wish to speak to them.
