

Request for Proposals (RFP)

McCreary County Schools

Sports Performance Weight Room Equipment and Installation

1. Introduction

McCreary County Schools is requesting proposals from qualified vendors for the purchase, delivery, and installation of sports performance weight room equipment for the McCreary County Sports Complex. This project is intended to support athletic development across multiple sports through high-quality, durable, and sport-specific training equipment.

2. Project Overview

McCreary County Schools plans to outfit a new weight room located within the **McCreary County Sports Complex**. The selected vendor will be responsible for providing commercial-grade equipment, coordinating delivery, and completing full installation to ensure the facility is ready for use.

The primary focus of this project is sports-specific training equipment, with an emphasis on twelve (12) power racks designed for use by middle school and high school student-athletes.

3. Scope of Work

The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- Design consultation and layout support (if available)
- Furnishing of all proposed weight training equipment
- Delivery of equipment to the McCreary County Sports Complex
- Full installation and setup of equipment
- Removal of packaging and cleanup after installation
- Final walkthrough and inspection

4. Equipment Requirements

Proposals should include equipment suitable for multi-sport athletic training. Vendors should clearly list all equipment included in their proposal.

Minimum requirements include:

- Twelve (12) commercial-grade power racks
- Adjustable benches compatible with racks
- Olympic barbells and bumper plates
- Storage solutions (plate trees, bar holders, rack-mounted storage, etc.)
- Sports performance accessories (e.g., pull-up attachments, band pegs, safety arms, etc.)
- Any additional recommended equipment that supports speed, strength, and power development

All equipment must be:

- Commercial or institutional grade
- Durable and appropriate for daily student-athlete use
- Compliant with applicable safety standards

5. Installation Requirements

The proposal must include:

- On-site installation by qualified technicians
- Anchoring and leveling of equipment as required
- Compliance with manufacturer specifications and safety standards
- Coordination with McCreary County Schools for scheduling

6. Vendor Qualifications

Vendors should provide:

- Company background and experience
- Experience with school or athletic facility installations
- References from similar projects (preferably K–12 or athletic facilities)
- Proof of insurance and applicable licenses

7. Proposal Submission Requirements

Proposals should include the following information:

1. Company name and contact information
2. Detailed equipment list and specifications
3. Layout or design rendering (if available)
4. Installation plan and timeline
5. Total project cost (itemized if possible)
6. Warranty information for equipment and installation
7. Estimated delivery and installation timeline

8. Evaluation Criteria

Proposals will be evaluated based on, but not limited to:

- Quality and durability of equipment
- Alignment with sports performance needs
- Vendor experience and references
- Installation plan and timeline
- Cost and overall value
- Warranty and post-installation support

9. Timeline

- Anticipated Award Date: February 25 2026
