



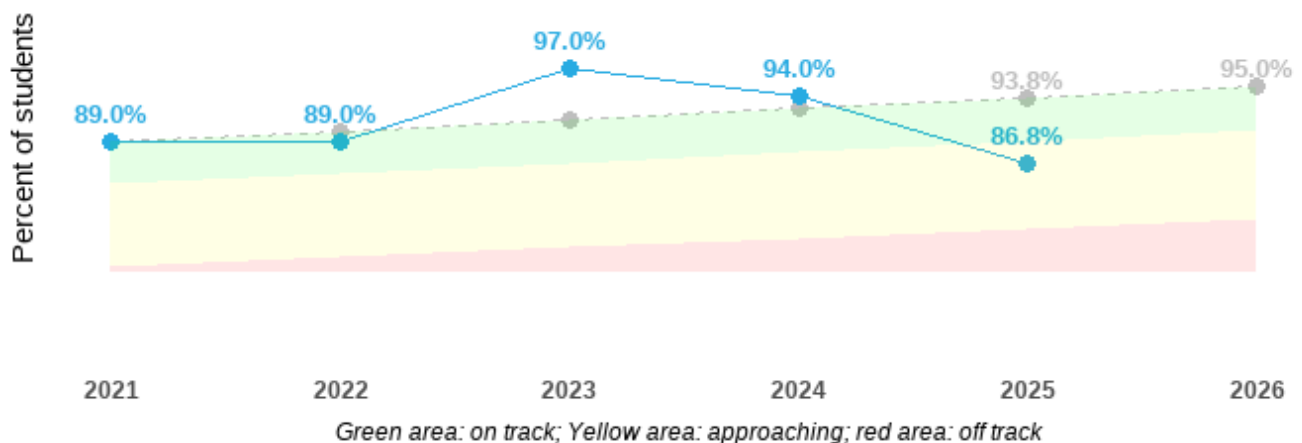
Tulsa Public Schools 2022-2027 Strategic Plan: Guardrail Monitoring Report

Guardrail 2: The superintendent will not allow the district to be in state corrective action regarding services to students with disabilities, including proper and timely identification.

Overall Guardrail Status: Off Track

Interim Guardrail 2.1: Percentage of children who are evaluated and whose eligibility for special education services is determined within 45 school days of parent consent will increase from 89% in June 2021 to 95% in June 2026.

Information about this interim

Timeliness is a requirement of IDEA. Regarding this guardrail, we have identified it as an important communication area that also aligns with federal compliance requirements. After a guardian signs consent for their student to be evaluated, the 45-school-day countdown begins. By adhering to the 45-day timeline, we also improve our ability to communicate with families in a timely manner. It also allows us to begin timely services for any students who are determined to be eligible for special education.
