**Upper Lake Unified School District Board Selects
Assistant Superintendent Tenderly Logan as New Superintendent, Pending Board Approval**

Ms. Logan to begin serving as Superintendent on July 1, 2026

UPPER LAKE, CA, February 6, 2026 - The Upper Lake Unified School District Board has announced its selection of Assistant Superintendent Tenderly Logan as the next superintendent of Upper Lake Unified School District. Ms. Logan will succeed Dr. Giovanni Annous on July 1, 2026.

Tenderly Logan is an accomplished district-level leader with over two decades of K-12 experience advancing equity, student well-being, and robust instructional and support systems. Since 2019, Logan has served the Upper Lake Unified School District (ULUSD). She began as Director of Special Education advancing to Assistant Superintendent of Pupil Personnel Services. She has also served as the District's Homeless Liaison, Foster Youth Liaison, and Title IX Officer.

In 2022, she rapidly launched ULUSD's first Extensive Support Needs (ESN) classrooms and developed the North Shore Collaborative, a three-district partnership that expands high-quality local ESN services and supports students in learning closer to home.

"After a comprehensive internal candidate interview process with highly qualified individuals, we have chosen a person who understands the unique spirit and values of our community. Their proven track record of collaborative leadership over all four school sites ensures that our students, teachers, and families will continue to thrive. The Board of Education looks forward to a bright future of partnership and shared success for our community," said Diane Plante, President of the Upper Lake Unified School District Board of Education.

Logan has a strong track record of improvements for district students, including establishing the District's first fully functional Pupil Personnel Services Department and leading a comprehensive turnaround of special education systems. Logan launched ULUSD's Wellness Center in 2020, creating an equity-based support center that connects students and families to essential support and community partnerships. In recognition of her results-driven leadership, Logan was named Special Education Administrator of the Year by the Association of California School Administrators in 2024 (ACSA).

She holds a Master of Arts in Educational Psychology, a B.A. in Liberal Studies, and maintains a Clear Administrative Services Credential, Pupil Personnel Services Credential, and Multiple Subject Teaching Credential. Logan also holds licensure as a Licensed Educational Psychologist and Licensed Professional Clinical Counselor, along with ACSA certifications in Superintendent, School Business, Curriculum and Instruction, Personnel Administration, and Pupil Services.
