Big Improvements Ahead: School Renovation Schedule



Construction and renovation projects approved in the November 2024 capital referendum will begin this summer, immediately after graduation. Following mobilization in early June, crews will be on-site for approximately 16–18 months.

The majority of major construction work will take place during the summer months to minimize disruption to students and staff during the school year. Miron Construction will manage the phasing of the entire project, with a strong focus on safety, efficiency, and coordination.
