1. Approved and seconded meeting minutes from previous meeting: Jim Maher and Richie Carnes
2. **Data Review/PLC Changes:** Trying to trickle in data discussions
3. **CCRPI:** Like schools and top schools reviewed. CVHS score was 92.5. CCRPI based off attendance, EOC scores, Pathway completion scores, etc. Last year was 85. So we saw growth and scored well. Goal is to get closer to some of those top schools in the state with scores like Pope's 97.1 and Lassiter's 95.4.
  - a. Discussed what changes lead to the jump from 85- 92.5. Admin visiting and sitting in on PLC meetings. Strong instructional admin team. Big push with Algebra score increases also contributed. Huge jump in special education scores.

4. **AP testing and EOC end of year procedures-** finalizing schedules to relieve some of the stress with moving classrooms and testing locations and teacher coverages.
5. **Scheduling and Allotments period:** Current prediction is a loss of 1 allotment. 28-30 kids per allotment plus changes to special populations is what decides it.
6. **Extracurriculars:** wrestling won another state championship. 7 in recent years with another possibly on the way.
  - a. **Guys and Dolls performance:** bragging on set pieces and the overall quality of the performance. Theater department is growing. Another chance to catch a performance on Sunday

**7. Construction:** almost officially done with construction. Paving all road surfaces and re-lining over spring break. Rumor has it we may be acquiring additional land for more parking. 27 new parking spots in the back of the school. New visitor parking spots being added to the front because of it.
