Grand, Michigan Ave., and S. Madison, ending at Marshall Middle School. SENIORS will then report to Marshall High School for Commencement. If inclement weather, the parade will be cancelled.

COMMENCEMENT: starts at 6:00 p.m. Arrive at Marshall High School by 5:45 p.m. Commencement will be held on the athletic field, weather permitting. CAP & GOWN must be worn.
