That is not the function of the committee or Board. G. Carraro asked if we are doing the bare minimum as far as nutrition. It was commented that our philosophy is stronger than the DOE Standards. We believe the current practice is aligned but not stronger than the standards. H. Blood will be speaking to S. Peters about wrapping up this portion of Nutrient.
