COURSE DESCRIPTIONS:

Build your welding skills through hands-on training designed for both beginners and advancing welders. Classes run concurrently, with placement based on prior experience to ensure appropriate, skill-level instruction.

Welding I introduces the fundamentals of Shielded Metal Arc Welding (SMAW), or stick welding. Students develop proper technique using 1/8" electrodes in flat, horizontal, and vertical-up positions while building a strong foundation in safety, equipment use, and weld quality.

Welding II builds on SMAW skills and introduces Gas Tungsten Arc Welding (GTAW), or TIG welding. Students refine technique, improve precision, and apply their skills to joint design and basic fabrication projects.
