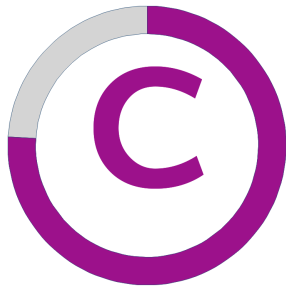

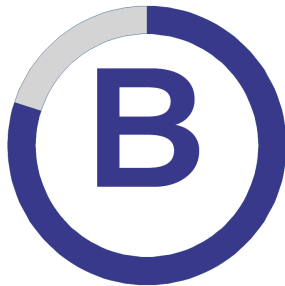

Overall Rating



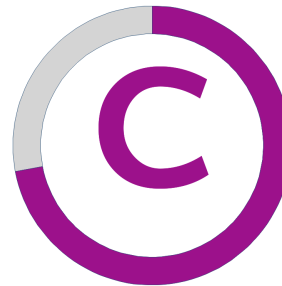

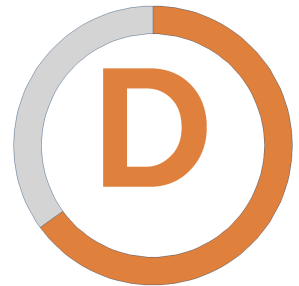
