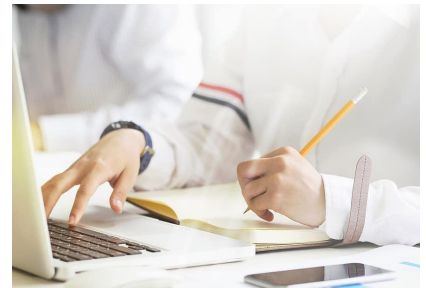

FALL

- Develop a list of prospective colleges/technical schools/military and other options based on research-keep in mind “Reach, Range and Reserve Schools”
- Register & prepare for ACT/SAT - Either fall or spring - speak with your counselor!

SPRING

- Narrow your list - plan college visits
- For service academies, the application process starts now!
- Schedule challenging senior courses
- Register for SAT/ACT if you haven't done so!
- Register for AP Tests
- Job shadowing
- Plan summer - internships, volunteering
- Complete 12 hours of community service (If not already done)

SUMMER

- Refine list & begin applications

Sophomores: October PSAT (Preliminary SAT)
