FREE STEM Opportunity- Feb. 21

Join the Engineering Honors Society, Tau Beta Pi, for a **free, hands-on** STEM experience designed for upper elementary students (Grades 3-5), on Saturday, February 21.

For this module, students will work alongside University of Michigan students and learn about buoyancy forces, density, and weight by building and testing boats in small groups. They will aim to build a boat that can hold the most amount of weight before sinking.
