## SPECIAL PROGRAMS - MULTILINGUAL LEARNERS, SPECIAL EDUCATION, AAP/HIGHLY CAPABLE

### Multilingual Students Receiving ELD Services

- **ELD** is an acronym for English Language Development.
- Students should select their required and elective courses on page 1. If they qualify for an ELD English Language Arts course, students will be placed in that course with parent notification. This course will replace the student's grade-level English Language Arts course.

### Students Receiving SPED Services

- **SPED** is an acronym for Special Education.
- Placement for required courses in their qualifying areas will be determined by each student's IEP team. This includes students in our FSA, Mid-Level, and LC programs. Please refer questions regarding placement to your student's case manager or counselor.

### Students Receiving AAP/Highly Capable Services:

- **AAP** is an acronym for Advanced Academic Placement.
- Students should select their elective courses on page 1. Qualifying students will automatically be placed into AAP/Highly Capable Math and English classes based on current year placements or information from the District.
- **Parents and Guardians of Highly Capable students:** If your student qualifies for AAP/Highly Capable courses and you prefer that they are NOT enrolled in AAP/Highly Capable courses, please email your student's counselor.
