EAGLE ZONE: Summer School Age Care

Eagle Zone (EZ) is a school-based child care program that provides care and adventure for students before and after school, on non-school days, and during the summer months. The summer program is a full-day program designed to support each child's social-emotional development. EZ offers a safe and nurturing environment staffed by educated and experienced professionals. Programs include opportunities for recreation, social skill development and academic enrichment within a supportive and familiar environment.

EPIC CAMPS & CLASSES: K-8 Youth Enrichment

Youth enrichment provides students with educational programs and activities that extend beyond their regular school day. Enrichment programs are designed to address youth needs in many areas such as academic, cultural, social, emotional, and recreational. The program boasts a wide range of offerings, including technology, art, music, languages, math, reading, science, sports/recreation, and more. Enrichment classes provide students the opportunity to improve academic and social skills, explore new interests, gain new skills, and make new friends.

Registration Options: Eagle Zone strives to provide flexible summer registration options to accommodate your student's needs. Review the options below to choose the best fit for your student this summer. **It's important to note that each student may only have one summer contract per student at a single location throughout the season, and families will not be able to switch between sites at any point during the summer.**



Cedar Ridge & Eden Lake Elementary

This summer at Cedar Ridge and Eden Lake, Eagle Zone is available for students who need full-day care only. Each grade group will enjoy tailored activities and trips designed for their specific age group.

Please ensure that you register your students for the grade group they will be entering in the Fall of 2026.

FULL DAY:

- **K-1st Grade:** Incoming kindergarten through first-grade students in the fall of 2026.
- **2nd-5th Grade:** Incoming second through fifth-grade students in the fall of 2026.

Forest Hills Elementary:

Forest Hills Eagle Zone is designed to support families enrolled in Targeted Services (TS) or Extended School Year (ESY), although this summer all families are welcome to register for full-day programming at this location. Registration will **not** be divided by grade level. Our on-site staff will tailor activities to effectively support all grades.

FULL DAY: Any student can register for full days, including Targeted Services or Extended School Year students and their siblings when class is not in session and full-day care is needed.

HALF DAY: Half days are **only** available for students while they are participating in Targeted Services or Extended School Year at Forest Hills. Half-day care is a weekly option and students must have a consistent schedule during the entire week they are enrolled. *Students must enroll in Eagle Zone for appropriate supervision after TS or ESY programming if additional care is needed.*

All registration options require a 14-day schedule change notice and a \$10 fee to change their schedule. Any days within that will be considered drop-in care and are not guaranteed. Half-days do not have a drop-in option.



Registration Dates & Fees

Registration opens online on **Monday, February 23 at 8:00 a.m.** at edenpr.arux.app. Registration acceptance will be on a first-come, first-served basis beginning spring 2026.

A one-time registration fee is charged on the following scale:

- February 23–March 23: Fee waived
- March 23–August 13: \$50/child non-refundable fee

Program Cost & Fees

DAILY RATES:

Full-Day (Cedar Ridge, Eden Lake and Forest Hills):

\$55/child per day (\$64 drop-in rate)

Drop-in is considered if the day of care is requested within 14 calendar days of when the care is needed.

Half-Day (Forest Hills only): \$135/child per week, Monday–Thursday

Student must be enrolled in a Targeted Services or Extended School Year class the same week.

ADDITIONAL FEES:

Late pick-up fees will apply to the families' account at \$1 per minute/child, after 6:00 p.m.

Late payment fee \$15

NEW AS OF JUNE 2026: All schedule changes made after the time of registration acceptance will be \$10 per schedule change per student.

A DAY AT SUMMER EAGLE ZONE:

Eagle Zone Summer programming is designed around choice-based experiences that give students opportunities to discover, explore, and pursue their interests throughout the week. Each week, students will participate in a mix of engaging experiences that may include:

- Clubs and enrichment activities based on student interests
- Community experiences and special events
- On-site experiences such as interactive assemblies, performers, and hands-on programs
- Community outings to places like swimming pools, parks, mini golf, local zoos, and more

Programming is structured to allow students to choose from a variety of activities, encouraging independence, creativity, and fun while still providing a safe and supportive environment.

What time does Eagle Zone start and end?

Full-day Eagle Zone opens at 7 a.m. and closes at 6 p.m. at all locations. Half-day Eagle Zone begins at noon and ends at 6 p.m. at Forest Hills.

We know that figuring out your family's summer schedule can be complicated! Unsure which to select? Take out the guesswork by following the flow chart below! Each student is limited to one summer contract at a single location for the entire season. Site changes will not be permitted during the summer. Please follow the flow chart for the best site for your student!

It is your choice!

It is up to each family if you would like your sibling who is not participating in Targeted Services or Extended School Year to go to Forst Hills or attend Cedar Ridge or Eden Lake.

Cedar Ridge and Eden Lake Summer Eagle Zone is designed programming for each specific grade group where Forest Hills Eagle Zone won't be divided by grades, but our on-site staff will tailor the programming to effectively address the needs of all students attending.

**Students are required to stay enrolled at Eagle Zone in one building for the duration of the summer.*



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is new this year?

Junior Eagle Zone Update: Junior Eagle Zone will no longer be offered as a stand-alone program due to total enrollment over the last few summers. Incoming kindergarten and 1st-grade students will participate together in intentionally designed, age-appropriate programming. This allows Eagle Zone to offer engaging activities that better align with students' developmental levels. This programming will be available at two school sites.

Summer Schedule Changes: To support safe, high-quality programming and effective staffing, a \$10 fee will apply to any schedule changes made after initial registration is created. This allows us to continue offering flexibility while reducing frequent last-minute changes for onsite teams.


Are there financial assistance options for Summer 2026?

Eagle Zone is certified with many Minnesota counties to receive childcare assistance. We also work with Childcare Aware for active military families. Please contact us for more information on the programs we utilize for childcare assistance.

How do I create a contract?

Every new season (school year and summer) families must create a new contract for each student. To create a new contract, go to edenpr.arux.app and click the Sign In button. Create a new account or log into an existing account. Register for the session you want by clicking on enroll now and follow the prompts.

Can I change my schedule?

Yes! All changes must be made outside of a 14-day calendar notice from the day you are looking to change. Contract changes can only be made after the contract has been accepted. All schedule changes will cost an additional \$10 change fee per student.

Is there transportation available?

There is no transportation available to and from Eagle Zone. An authorized person must drop off and pick up all students and provide a signature.



Lunch Bunch is a supervised mid-day program for students attending **both** morning and afternoon camps. EPIC Staff will pick up students directly from their morning class and escort them to the cafeteria to enjoy lunch with friends. After eating, students can participate in supervised free play and activities in a safe, supportive environment.

Lunch Bunch is a convenient and fun way for campers to recharge and stay engaged throughout the day.

Registration for Lunch Bunch is required for students enrolled in both a morning and afternoon class who will be staying all day. Students must bring their own non-refrigerated lunch.

Program Costs

EPIC Camps & Classes are fee-based courses that vary in cost, based on operating expenses, including working with third-party vendors in specific camps.

Cancellation & Refund Policy

Any cancellation to an EPIC class or registration modification **MUST** be emailed to EPIC@edenpr.org. Full refunds will only be made up to 7 calendar days before the class begins. Refund requests made within 7 calendar days of the class start date or after the class has started will not be eligible for a refund. **There is a processing fee of \$10 for any EPIC registration cancellation. However, if your child's registration is canceled due to enrollment in Targeted Services, the \$10 cancellation fee will be waived.**

To transfer your student's registration to a different class, please email us at EPIC@edenpr.org. We'll be happy to assist you with the change.

If your student(s) is absent from class, you will not be refunded for missing that day of class. Please notify us at EPIC@edenpr.org if your student is going to be absent.

No. You are responsible for dropping your student(s) off and picking them up from Summer EPIC. We do not offer transportation from site to site or from the school to/from home.





What if I want my student(s) to attend afternoon programming in addition to Targeted Services?

Students referred to Targeted Services may participate in Eden Prairie Schools summer youth programming – EPIC camps & classes or Eagle Zone school-age care. If interested, families must register separately for these programs.

Summer youth program registration (EPIC and Eagle Zone) opens Monday, February 23, 2026 at 8 a.m. at edenpr.arux.app.

What does the schedule look like when participating in both Targeted Services and afternoon summer youth programming?

MORNING: TARGETED SERVICES

Students attend their referred Targeted Services program at Forest Hills Elementary. *If a student lives in Eden Prairie, free busing to Forest Hills is available.*

AFTERNOON: YOUTH PROGRAMMING OPTIONS

Students who wish to add afternoon programming to their morning Targeted Services session have two options:

Option 1: EPIC (Grades K-5)

- Students may attend an afternoon EPIC program at Prairie View Elementary. Free busing is available from Targeted Services to EPIC, but **registration is required.**
- Supervised lunch is included upon arrival at Prairie View.

- Rental of Eden Prairie Schools facilities
- Opportunities to give back through the district-wide Sharing Inspiration Volunteer Program, advisory councils, or planning committees for events such as PeopleFest! or the GIVE Gathering
- Family School for Multilingual families
- Free academic support through Eagles Homework Help & Tutoring
- Cultural liaison support for the Somali and Spanish-speaking communities in Eden Prairie
