

Article 8. Shall the voters of Cambridge Town School District rename the reserve established for STUDENT PANDEMIC RECOVERY to be named UNFUNDED STUDENT PROGRAMMING, which will be used for supporting unfunded student programming?

Article 9. Shall the voters of Cambridge Town School District authorize the Board of School Directors for the Cambridge Elementary School to hold the audited fund balance as of June 30, 2025, in the amount of \$92,645, in the newly renamed reserve UNFUNDED STUDENT PROGRAMMING to be expended under the control and direction of the Board of School Directors?


AUSTRALIAN BALLOT ARTICLE

Article 10. Shall the Cambridge Town School District approve the proposed education spending for the twelve months ending June 30, 2027, in the amount of \$6,708,903, which is the amount determined to be necessary for the ensuing year? It is estimated that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$13,441, per pupil. This projected spending per pupil is 2.9% lower than spending for the current year.




