



Moving to Asynchronous Remote Learning Snow Days

The district has used all three traditional snow days that were included in the approved calendar!

Any future weather-related school closures for this school year will be **remote learning days**. Students will be expected to complete academic assignments asynchronously from home. If you have a pre-scheduled IEP or 504 meeting, those will still be held, pending no power outages. Remote learning days will not need to be added to the calendar at the end of the year. There is a [dedicated page](#) on our school website that more fully describes weather-related closures. Additionally, each school has sent out specific information about the expectations and procedures for those days.



Food Service Plans for Remote Learning Days -

Meals will be provided during remote learning snow days. Non-perishable meals have already been sent home in advance with all students for whom a meal has been requested. [Please fill out this form](#) to have your child's name added to the list of kids receiving a meal or communicate with us if you believe you signed up previously and have not seen that food sent home with your child.

If you have multiple children, please fill out the form for each child individually. After each remote learning snow day, we will send home another non-perishable meal for possible future remote

learning days. You do not need to resubmit on the form again for each remote learning snow day. Once you are on the list you are on it for the winter, if you would like to be removed from the list, please contact your school.

We are delighted to welcome our newest students to Scarborough Public Schools for Kindergarten in the 2026-2027 school year!

Eligibility

Kindergarten is open to any student who turns five (5) years old on or before October 15, 2026.

How to Register

All prospective students must complete the New Student Enrollment Form. If your child meets the age requirement but you are undecided about enrollment due to developmental level or other concerns, please complete the registration form anyway—this helps us plan accurately for all potential students.

AVOID TOUCHING EYES, NOSE AND MOUTH


Hands touch many surfaces and can pick up viruses. Once contaminated, hands can transfer the virus to us through your eyes, nose or mouth
