Patrons will be sent an electronic confirmation/receipt signifying successful online enrollment in your course(s). Please ensure an email address is provided when registering as email is our primary form of communication.

**Course Cancellations**

In the event of course cancellation, patrons will be notified via email at least three (3) business days before the start date and full credits/refunds will be issued in the event the Department cancels a course you are enrolled in. If original payment method was check, a check refund will be processed. For payment by credit card, a refund will be issued to your original payment method if within 120 days. If after 120 days then a check refund will be issued.
