## ACADEMIC PROGRAM & REQUIREMENTS:

- Honors courses offered in the major disciplines in grades 9-12
- Grades 9, 10, and 11 – minimum of six courses, grade 12 – minimum of five courses
- Options Program: an inclusive educational experience for students with special needs. Students with mild to moderate intellectual disabilities are included in neurotypical classrooms for 80-100% of the day.
- Academic Levels: Students are placed based on academic performance, standardized test scores, and teacher recommendations. Students may have customized learning plans involving more than one instructional level.
  - A2 – College Preparatory: Designed for students who need a more guided approach to their studies.
  - A1 – College Preparatory: Offers some independent study and fast paced learning.
  - Honors/AP: Challenges gifted students.

## ADVANCED PLACEMENT:

Departmental approval and strong academic standing are required for all students who wish to enroll in an AP class. For the 2024-2025 school year, 94% of students received a 3 or better on their AP test and were eligible for college credit and 67% received a 4 or a 5. The following sixteen AP courses are offered for the 2025-26 school year.
