

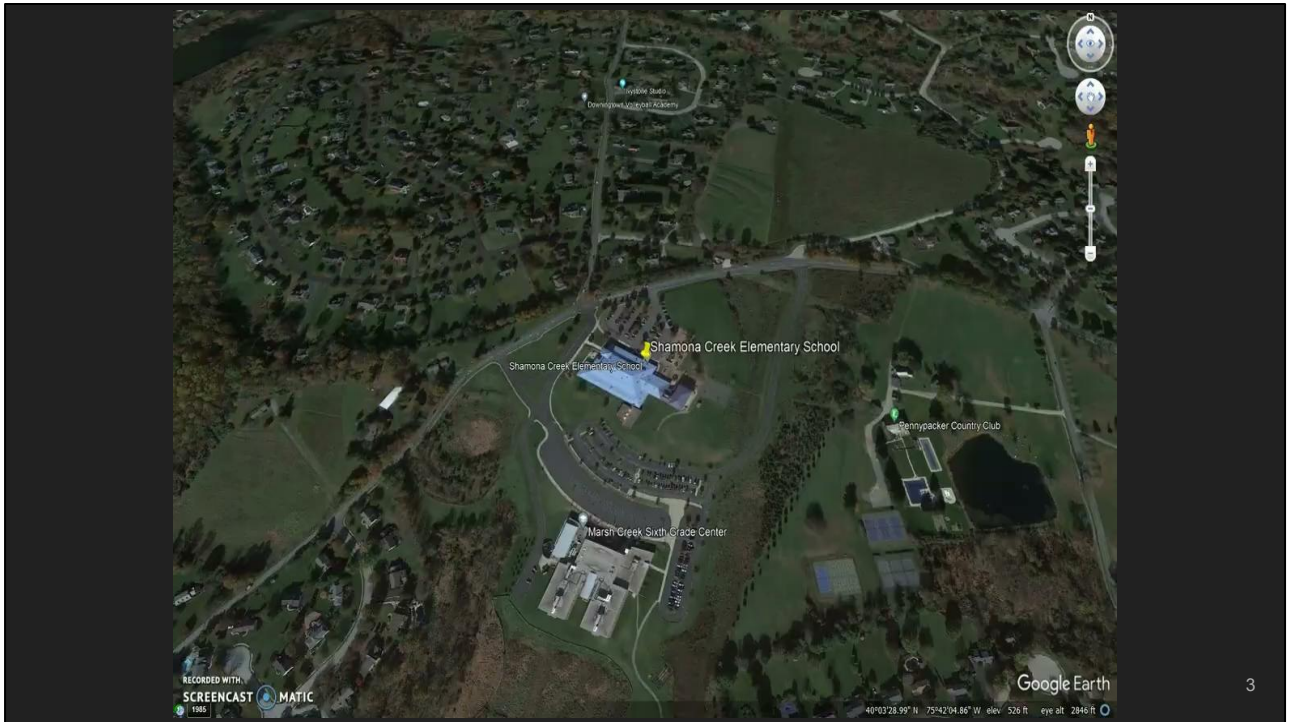


Lynn: Review assembly expectations

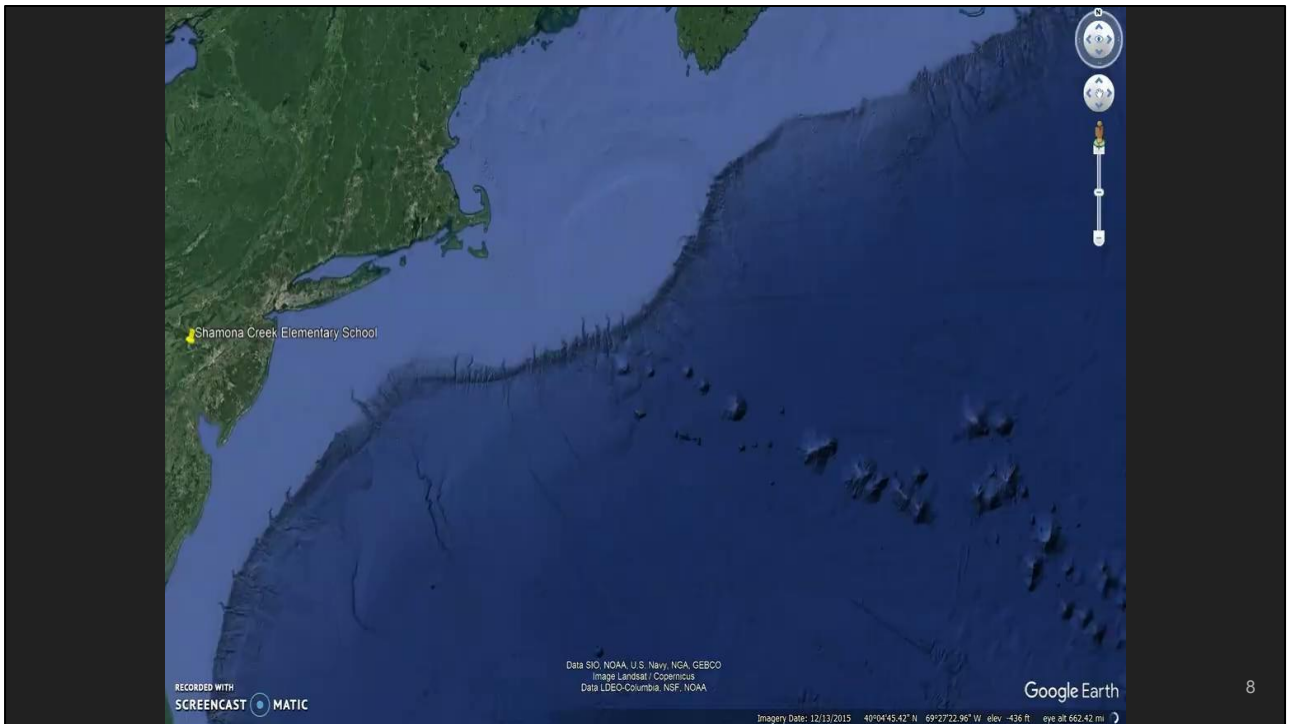

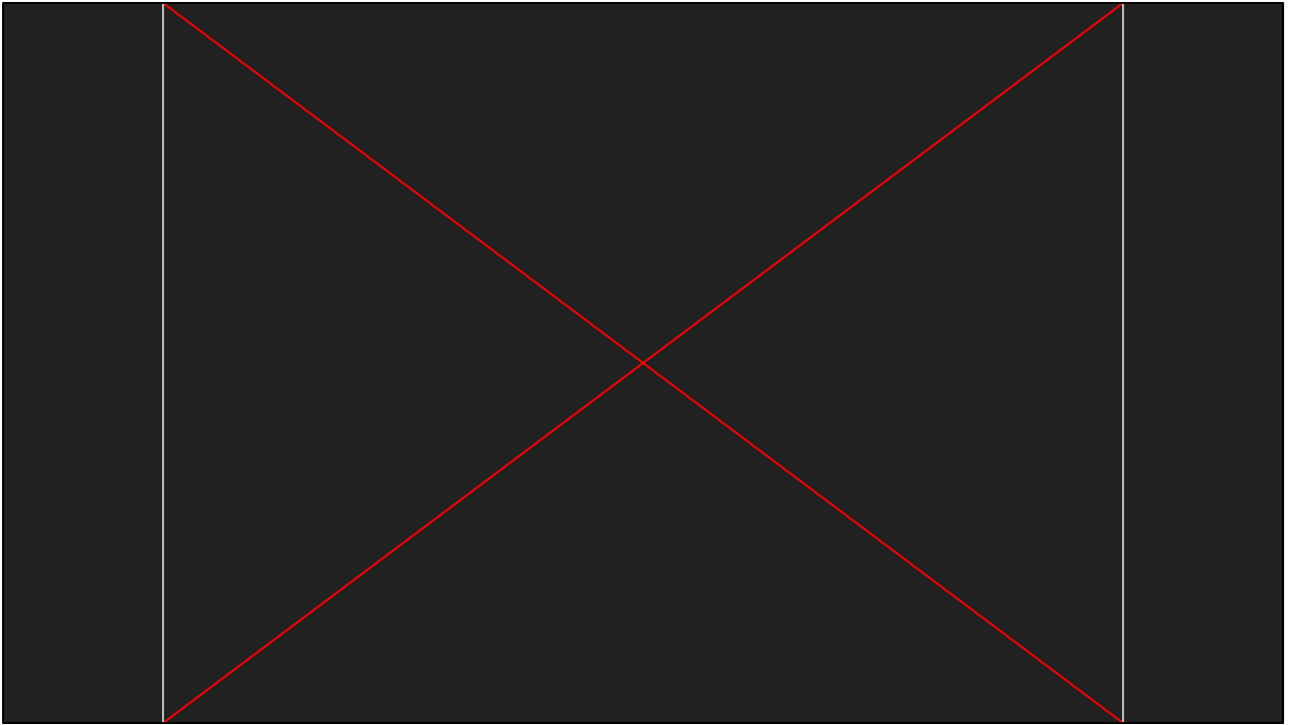

Bhavagna Kolla will be performing a Bollywood dance.

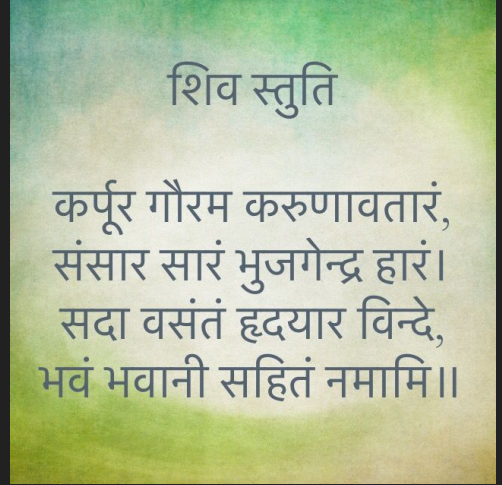
