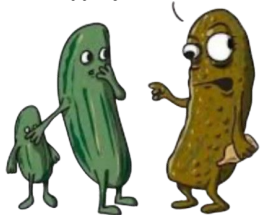

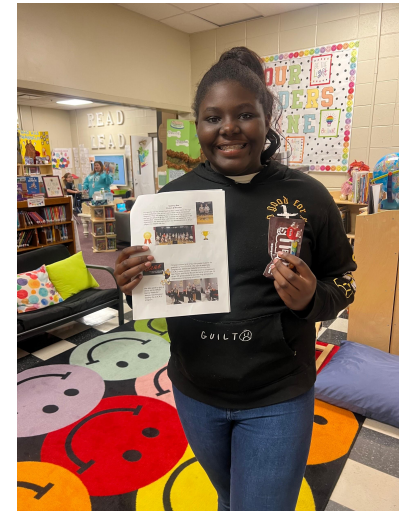

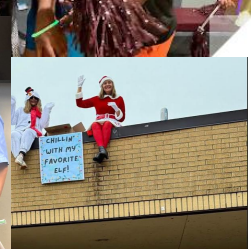

We thank you so much for helping our students feel safe and loved on the bus each day, Mr. Sammy.

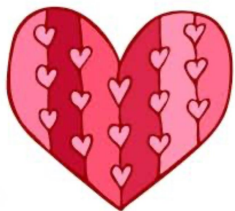
National Counselors' Week

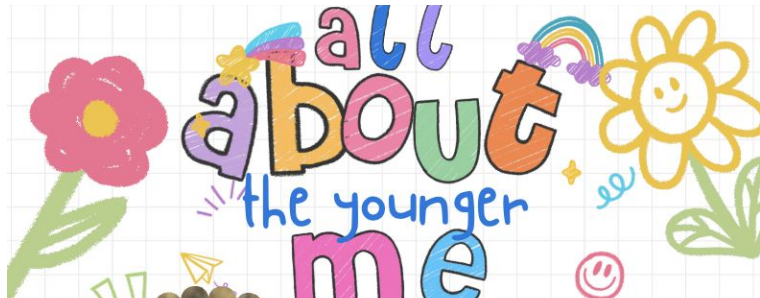

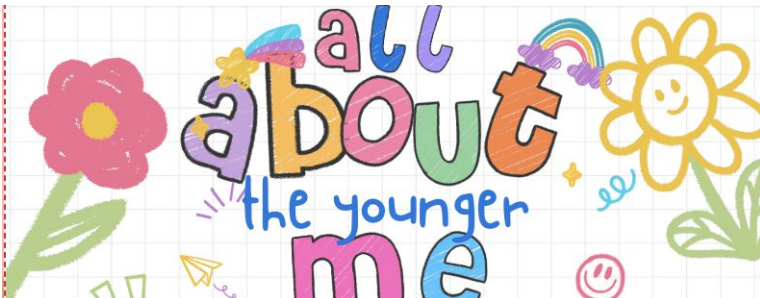
