

Dual Enrollment at Chattooga High School 2026-2027

The Dual Enrollment program at Georgia Northwestern Technical College allows high school students to enroll in college courses while still in high school to earn credit for both high school and college courses simultaneously. Our program is nationally accredited by the National Alliance of Concurrent Enrollment Partnerships (NACEP). Students may take courses on a GNTC campus, online, or at their high school. Courses are available for fall, spring, and summer semesters. Tuition and books are covered for the first 30 hours for students who meet eligibility requirements. Whether a student plans to attend a 4-year university or wants to obtain a career skill for quicker entry into the workforce, the Dual Enrollment program is a great way to make it happen.

Students must complete an online application to Georgia Northwestern Technical College, as well as a Dual Enrollment Funding Application in GA Futures. Parents/Guardians must complete the **Parent Acknowledgement** section of the GA Futures Dual Enrollment Funding Application.
