

Governance of the Board

Ad Hoc Committees

The President of the Board of Trustees shall appoint on an as needed basis, all temporary, special, and advisory committees as may be deemed necessary and advisable by the Board. All temporary, special, and advisory committee duties shall be outlined at the time of organization and the committee(s) shall be considered dissolved when its final report has been made to the Board.

The makeup of these committees and committee appointments shall be at the discretion of the President. However, each Board committee shall be chaired by a Board member and Board members shall comprise the majority of each committee.

Where deemed appropriate by the President, members of the greater community including faculty, staff, administration, students, parents and other parties may be appointed to any committee and shall possess equal status in the committee process. In the case where a vote of committee members is necessary, this vote shall be recorded and reported to the Board. All committees of the Board shall follow the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act as required.
