## Program overview

Camp Erin King and Snohomish Counties are free grief camps for youth ages 6-17 grieving the death of a significant person in their lives. Kids and teens attend a weekend, overnight camp that combines grief support with fun camp activities. Campers explore their grief, build coping skills, and make friends in a supportive community. Camps are led by grief support professionals and trained volunteers from Providence at Home with Compassus.
