- The School Growth Fund is currently allocated to the building refits. The annual School Growth fees and the Registration fees are allocated to the ISL School Growth Fund.
- The Stability reserve is to protect the sustainability of the school and to help alleviate future fee increases due to fluctuations in the government's subsidy, enrolment and extraordinary economic circumstances.
- The Tuition fees are to fund the annual operational budget of the school.

The registration fee secures a new applicant's initial registration. In the successive years, the annual Stability Reserve fee is payable during the annual enrolment as a non-refundable deposit to secure a student's place for the following school year. On signature of enrolment acceptance, all above school fees are committed to.

Please note that the school fees benefit from the Luxembourg State Subsidy for private schools which presently averages approximately €12,755 per child. Without this State subsidy the tuition fees payable would increase by a similar amount.

Additional Schooling Costs

All School Required

- Grade level residential experiences in the form of nature-based learning camps and other trips are a key element of a student's learning journey at our school. These residential experiences are mandatory for all students and take place in Grade 2 through Grade 10. Each experience is designed to be age appropriate in terms of its length, location, and the activities they involve. These trips will be charged to the student's account.
- Textbooks, books and equipment loaned to the students will be charged if not returned or returned in bad condition.
- An ISL School Physical Education uniform (from Grade 3).
- If applicable, special additional support may be invoiced based on the individual's situation. Non-ISL online courses including Pamoja and Global Online Academy may be charged when optional.

Lower School Required

- Healthy snacks from Grade 1 to Grade 5 (€ 340), per school year, will be charged to the student's account on attendance during the school year per child (unless a formal doctor's Personal Allergy Plan (PAI) certificate regarding food allergy is formalised with the school nurse and unable to be catered for by the School's external caterer. In the case of late arrival, a 10% reduction will be applied for any calendar month not enrolled.
- Class Funds for events organised by homeroom parents for Foundations to Grade 1 (€ 20) and for Grade 2 to Grade 5 (€ 10) will be charged to the student's account in October. Arrivals after October will not be charged but a kind request to donate to the Parent Community Group will be made.

Upper School Required

- Students are required to bring their own personal laptop [per school specifications](#)
- Students will require personal supplies and basic scientific calculator
- From Grade 7, upper school students are required to have a TI-Inspire (non-CAS) Calculator. The purchase will be proposed to be purchased (€ 151) via the student's SchoolsBuddy wallet.
- Replacements of student cards online (€ 10)
- Replacement of any books or textbooks provided by school
- Class Funds for events organised by Advisory parents for Grades 6 to Grade 11 (€ 10) and Grade 12 (€ 30) will be charged to the student's account on enrolment. Arrivals after October will not be charged but a kind request to donate to the Parent Community Group will be made.

Additional senior events are organised for Grade 12 by the Senior Parent Committee independently from the school.

Voluntary Commitments

- Upper School lunches and cafeteria purchases transit through the school's caterer MyLunch on-line platform. The daily cafeteria limit per Upper School student card is € 25 and pre-paid funds are made available by parents/guardians via credit card.
- Lower School lunches as ordered and paid by credit card through the school's caterer MyLunch on-line platform.
- Cafeteria prices are set at the start of the school year, and one increase may take place during the school year. School subsidy on school lunches borne by the school is set in parallel.
- Voluntary school activities may incur additional charges. All school related signups will transit through the school's online platform SchoolsBuddy and be payable by credit card.
- After school Stay'n Play seasonal camp fees.
- Team sports kit is required for team participation.
- Instrument rental when needed is charged on sign-up with the school band with recommended updated household insurance.
- Individual tutoring organised by parents is considered a parental decision.
- After school activities not organised by the school, even if on the school premises are not the school's responsibility.
- Insurance for personal property and travel insurance: the school strongly recommends that parents or guardians provide insurance for all students' personal property as well as travel insurance for trips. Students attending ISL are covered by the mandatory government insurance furnished by the Association d 'Assurance Contre Les Accidents (AAA).

Annual Tuition fees include:

All external examinations and benchmark assessments including but not limited to IBO exams, MAP, CAT4, PASS.

Foundations, Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten: Healthy morning snacks, books, class supplies, possible sign-up to Stay'n Play

Grades 1 to 5: Books, class supplies, class supplies, possible sign-up to Playground Clubhouse and numerous extra-curriculum activities organised by the School

Grades 6 to 12: Textbooks loan, books, class supplies, possible sign-up to numerous extra-curriculum activities organised by the School, access to services within the school's guidance and careers programme.



Late Entries

If a student is registered to start during the school year, a 10% tuition reduction from the full annual tuition will be granted for each full calendar month the student is not registered

For all late enrolment and registration, please carefully take note of the conditions applicable for Early Withdrawal and Registration cancellation. School fees will be owed immediately on signature of the enrolment contract.

Children joining the Early Years Programme will generally be scheduled to start school on a Wednesday.

Children joining Grades 1 to 5 will generally be scheduled to start school on a Monday.

Early Withdrawal and Registration cancellation

Formal written notification of withdrawal, signed by the parents/guardians, is to be addressed to the Business Office. The official withdrawal notification must be either by:

1. [Online form available on the school website](#)
2. Letter sent by registered mail
3. Letter scanned back to islfinances@islux.lu for formal school receipt,
4. Letter personally handed in to the Business Office to collect proof of official school receipt.

Notification is ideally sent as early as possible, in advance of the actual date of departure or non-arrival. Any outstanding balance at the time of departure will result in the school records being withheld.

An [Official School Notification Form](#) is available on our website.

In the event that the school must close its premises or delay entry, due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control, tuition fees and other fees shall not be reimbursed and be considered owed.

Your school fees are contractually binding once you sign the enrolment agreement, even if you have not received an invoice yet or even if no effective attendance takes place.

If withdrawal or registration cancellation is notified **on or before 30th June**, the 2026-2027 Stability Reserve fee (returning students) and the Entry fees (new students) remain owed and non-refundable. **Past 30th June**, all students will forfeit and owe the full Annual School Growth fee and Stability fee and a percentage of Annual Tuition Fees based on the notification and the departure date:

School Fees will be owed based on date of notification and withdrawal or registration cancellation with important pivot dates being 30th June, 30th November and 31st December

Past 30th June 2026, registered and enrolled students will forfeit and owe the **full 2026-2027 Annual School Growth fee** and **Stability fee** and the following percentage of **Annual Tuition Fees** based on the notification and the departure date:

Understanding Your Payment Obligations

Your school fees are contractually binding once you sign the enrolment agreement, even if you have not received an invoice yet or even if no effective attendance takes place. The payment schedule, including all due dates, is clearly listed at the bottom of your invoice. Invoices for annual school fees are issued once your annual enrolment contract is submitted.

Payment Options and Due Dates

You can choose from two payment plans to settle your school fees:

Standard Instalment Plan

- At least 67% of the total annual fees is due by 30 June.
- The remaining 33% is due by 1 February.

Quarterly Instalment Plan

Alternatively, you can pay in four instalments on the following due dates:

- 1 June
- 1 September
- 1 December
- 1 March

If you choose the quarterly option, setting up a standing order with your bank is strongly encouraged.

Joining Mid-Year?

If your child joins the school during the academic year, the payment due dates will be adjusted based on when the invoice is issued. Any missed payments must be settled immediately upon receiving the invoice to stay aligned with the remaining schedule.

Initial payments

- The registration fee secures a new applicant's initial registration. In successive years, the annual Stability Reserve fee is payable during the annual enrolment as a non-refundable deposit to secure a student's place for the following school year. On signature of enrolment acceptance, all school fees are committed to.
- All Activities and Cafeteria Purchases are to be pre-paid online via credit card.

Important Notes

- The school reserves the right to delay entry, withhold school records, charge interest on overdue accounts, or initiate a collection process for any outstanding balances.
- If your fees are paid by a company, third party, or someone other than the parents or guardians, please complete the [Third party authorisation form](#) available on our website.
