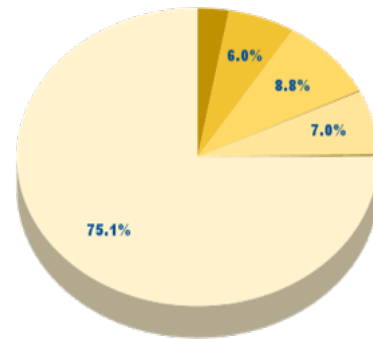

SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

Liberty North High School is a comprehensive 4-year public high school, serving nearly 2300 students in grades 9-12. LNHS is part of Liberty Public Schools, an award-winning school district of over 12,000 students and located near Kansas City, Missouri. LPS is comprised of 11 elementary schools, 4 middle schools, 2 high schools, an alternative high school, and an early childhood center. Liberty North – Home of the Eagles - opened in the fall of 2010 and, since that time, has grown to one of the largest high schools in the state. At LNHS, our mission is building learners and future leaders thorough inclusion, instruction, and innovation.

MISSOURI A+ DESIGNATED HIGH SCHOOL

The A+ program requires students to complete 50 hours of tutoring / mentoring, maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher, have 95% attendance during grades 9-12, and earn a proficient or advanced score on the Algebra 1 EOC exam in order to be A+ certified.

LPS offers three diploma types – Silver, Gold, and Platinum – and offers a weighted GPA for all Advanced Placement (AP) and Dual Credit (DC) classes. Additionally, LPS requires all students to earn at least one Market Value Asset (MVA) prior to graduation.

Silver diploma earners attain the state minimum of 24 credits and earn 1 MVA. Gold diploma earners attain the LPS standard of 25.5 credits and earn 2 MVA. Platinum diploma earners attain the maximum of 28 credits and earn 2 MVAs.

Students receive an additional 1.0 point to reflect the grades they earn in AP and DC classes: A=5.0, B=4.0, C=3.0, D=2.0, F=0.0
