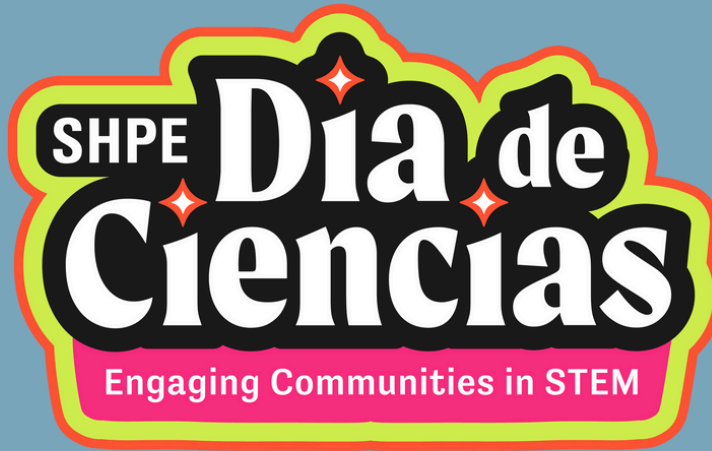

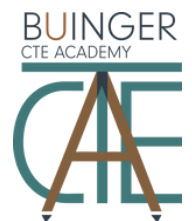

# How to sign up for Free/Reduce Lunch

The 89th Texas Legislature approved funding through the General Appropriations Act to ensure that students who qualify for reduced-price school meals can receive both breakfast and lunch at no cost for the next two years. State funding for reduced-price meals took effect on September 1, 2025. If you have already applied for and been approved for reduced-price meals, no action is needed. If you have not completed an application for free or reduced-price meals and believe you may be eligible, please do so at [www.NLAPPSCLOUD.com](http://www.NLAPPSCLOUD.com). 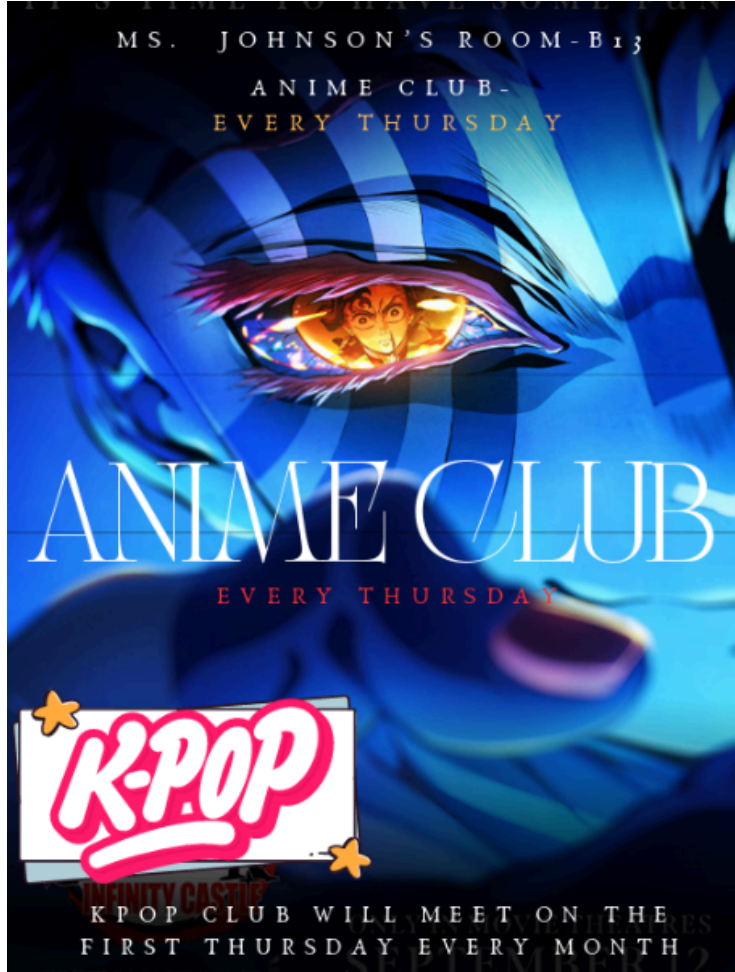
