



Gym and Multi-Purpose Room Facility Usage Guidelines

Safety is our first priority.

Please do not drop children off unless presence of responsible party has been confirmed.

Please do not leave children unsupervised in gyms or multi-purpose rooms.

Coaches or responsible party must ensure that all children have been picked up before leaving the building.

Confirmations and Scheduling

School activities always take priority. All facility use is conditional upon school activities and needs.

Please be considerate of other groups scheduled to use the building by adhering to your scheduled times and scheduled areas. You will not be allowed in the scheduled area until the confirmed time as indicated on your confirmation.

Guidelines

- No street shoes are allowed on gym floors. Athletic shoes that leave no scuff marks on the floors must be worn for athletic uses.
- Water, in bottles with lids, is allowed in gym. Food and drinks, other than water, are limited to multi-purpose rooms and cafeterias only.
- No baseballs, softballs, batting cages, bats of any kind are allowed in the gyms or multi-purpose rooms.
- Soccer – gyms may be used for futsal or conditioning purposes only. Soccer goals may not be brought into school facilities.
- Use of building PE equipment is prohibited except for volleyball nets and basketball goals.
- Volleyball nets must be set up and taken down with the assistance from custodian and supervisor.
- Not all basketball goals in the middle school gyms can be adjusted. Elementary basketball goals may be adjusted. Please seek assistance from school staff. Be sure to specify goal height on usage request.
- High school gyms are not available for community use.
- Please be respectful to all district personnel and school property. Failure to do so may lead to suspension of rental privileges and reimbursement of any damaged property.
- Please make sure everyone associated with the group (siblings, parents, etc.) stays in the assigned area.
- Refrain from bouncing balls or practicing in the hallway.
