To be eligible for a scholarship, the applicant must:

1. Be a Tracy/Mountain House resident and graduating senior from Tracy High, Merrill West, John Kimball, George & Evelyn Stein, Millennium, Mountain House High School, or Delta Charter School in the year application is made.
2. Intend to enroll in an accredited two- or four-year college or university or trade school program.

The awards will be based on **community service** and leadership. Funds will be dispersed upon evidence of attendance at the school, college, or university. In the event that the winner does not attend a school, college, or university beginning in the fall semester immediately following completion of high school, the scholarship will be forfeited.
