WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THIS POSITION?

The Cook Manager has charge of the preparation and cooking of food in a medium size school. This work involves the preparation and cooking of food on a moderately large scale and the supervision of personnel of a school lunch room. The work is performed under general supervision of a school lunch manager or other supervisor. Supervision is exercised over the work of cooks and food service helpers. Does related work as required.

WHO ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

Good knowledge of the principles and practices of a large quantity food preparation, menu planning, purchasing, sanitary food handling, and storage; good knowledge of the fundamental of nutrition and their application to the health of children; good knowledge of modern cooking utensils; knowledge of food service HACCP (Hazard Analysis Critical Control Points), sanitation standards, procedures, and required paperwork; good knowledge of appliances and equipment and their proper use; ability to plan and supervise the work of others; ability to keep records and prepare reports; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.
