The Mansfield ISD Pre-Kindergarten program maintains a strong early childhood foundation that is developmentally appropriate, multisensory and experiential. Young learners are provided a learning environment that inspires curiosity, builds confidence and fosters a love of learning. Curriculum for this program is an integration of experience-based active explorative learning and the Texas Education Agency (TEA) Pre-Kindergarten Guidelines ([English](#) / [Spanish](#)).

Mansfield ISD offers a full-day Pre-Kindergarten program that follows the district calendar and the elementary school bell schedule, 8:00 a.m.-3:30 p.m. The program is offered at 18 campuses.

Mansfield ISD Pre-Kindergarten Program Options

Mansfield ISD provides free Pre-Kindergarten for students who are four (4) years of age on or before September 1 of the current school year and who *meet one of eligibility criteria* as outlined by the Texas Education Agency listed below:

- Unable to speak and comprehend the English language;
- Economically Disadvantaged (qualifies for free or reduced lunches);
- Homeless (as defined by 42 United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 1143a);
- Child of an active duty member of the armed forces of the United States, including state military forces or a reserve component of the armed forces, who is ordered to active duty (must be on active duty the first day of school);
- Child of a member of the armed forces of the United States, including state military forces or a reserve component of the armed forces, who was injured or killed while serving on active duty;
- Child is, or ever has been, in the conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services following an adversary hearing. This also includes children who have been adopted or returned to their parents; or
- Child of a person eligible for the Star of Texas Award as: a peace officer under Section 3106.002, Government Code; a firefighter under Section 3106.003, Government Code; or an emergency medical first responder under Section 3106.004, Government Code
- Child of a person employed as a classroom teacher at a public primary or secondary school in the school district that offers a prekindergarten class under this section

Four Pre-Kindergarten Programs

1. Eligibility Pre-Kindergarten

Students who are four (4) years of age on or before September 1 of the current school year and who meet one of eligibility criteria as outlined by the Texas Education Agency may be enrolled in Pre-Kindergarten free of charge.

2. Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE)

Students in ECSE are ages 3-4, identified with a disability, and demonstrate a need for special education. The primary goal of ECSE is to provide early intervention that prepares students for

success in general education or in the least restrictive environment. The instructional focus is to provide opportunities for learning that are appropriate for each child’s developmental level. In alignment with best practices for early childhood education, the ECSE program facilitates the mastery of the Individualized Education Program (IEP) goals of each student. There is no cost associated with any ECSE services, including participation in the Pre-K program.





- Child Find: If you have concerns regarding the development of your preschool child and would like to talk with someone regarding your concerns, please contact one of the members of the Preschool Assessment Team. Mansfield ISD staff will work with you to ensure that every child receives an appropriate evaluation and determine which children have a disability that qualifies for services. Services are offered to all children free of charge.

3. Bilingual Pre-Kindergarten

MISD offers Bilingual Pre-K following a one-way, 90/10 dual language model, in which 90% of the instruction is delivered in Spanish and the other 10% is delivered in English. The one-way model is for students identified as English Learners whose home language is Spanish. Students are identified by taking a language assessment and must qualify for the program. One-way Bilingual Pre-K is offered at the following campuses:

4. Tuition-Based Pre-Kindergarten

Mansfield ISD offers tuition-based Pre-Kindergarten to students who do not meet eligibility criteria as outlined by TEA. This may be offered at every campus with a Pre-K program; there are limited seats for this program as openings are based on enrollment numbers at each campus. *Parents are encouraged to enroll their child first to determine eligibility before deciding on tuition-based opportunity.*

- **Tuition-base PK at J.L. Boren Elementary School, Anna May Daulton, Annette Perry, Cora Spencer Elementary School, Judy K. Miller, and Jandrucko Academy for Early Learners**
 - The **interest application link** for these campuses will open at 8:00 AM on April 1 and close at 6:00 PM on April 8. A lottery system is used for acceptance in the program at these campuses, and parents will be notified. Those who apply, but are not provided with a seat, will be placed on a waiting list and notified once a seat is opened.

- **Tuition-based PK at Other MISD Elementary School Campuses**
 - The interest/waiting list opens on April 17.
 - Interested parents may complete the **Waiting List Form**. This districtwide waiting list will be dated and time stamped in the order it is received so that we can provide equity as much as possible across the district as opportunities are offered on a first-come-first-serve basis.
 - Parents may choose more than one campus to be added to the waiting list.

- **Important to Note:**
 - Tuition-based PK is only offered for Mansfield ISD residents and staff members.
 - All registration documentations are required for enrollment.
 - Once a tuition-based opportunity is offered, parents have 24 hours to accept the invitation.
 - Transportation **will be available** under the following conditions:
 - Bus transportation **is only available** to students enrolled at their designated **home campus**, based on the student's residential address.
 - You can verify your child's home campus [by entering your home address here](#).
 - **Transportation Will Not Be Provided for:**
 - Students attending a Pre-K program **outside** their designated MISD attendance zone.
 - Students who **live within two miles** of their home campus.
 - MISD will continue to follow the existing **two-mile walk zone** and **hazardous route** criteria, as established by the school board, to determine transportation eligibility.

- **Note:** All eligible Pre-K through 1st-grade students must have a bus tag and must be met at the bus stop by a parent or guardian in order to exit the bus, unless accompanied by an older sibling. Older siblings must be in second grade or older. No exceptions.

- **Tuition | Payment Process:**

- Full-day tuition is \$550 per month and due the first day of every month during the regular school term (September - May).
- Parents have the following options for payment: Online Skyward E-Check payment (.75 fee), Online Skyward Credit Card (over 4% fee), or provide cash/money order/check to the campus.

Documentation Requirement for PK Eligibility

Documentation of eligibility is required upon enrollment. Review the list below for the approved documentation required for each noted eligibility.

New Enrollment Process

Parents should complete all necessary registration steps online in Skyward [Online enrollment](#), which includes submitting required documents. If assistance with online registration and document submission is needed, parents may call the home campus to request an appointment to register in person.

Pre-Kindergarten students whose home campuses are: Janet **Brockett** Elementary, Kenneth **Davis** Elementary, Imogene **Gideon** Elementary, Glenn **Harmon** Elementary, Thelma **Jones** Elementary or D.P. **Morris** Elementary will register at Dr. Sarah K. Jandrucko Academy for Early Learners. Upon eligibility, students will attend Jandrucko for Pre-K.

Pre-Kindergarten students whose home campus is Brenda **Norwood** Elementary will register at Annette Perry Elementary. Upon eligibility, students will attend Perry for Pre-K.

Documentation Requirement for Enrollment

The following documentations are required for enrollment:

1. Student's Social Security Card
2. Student's Birth Certificate/Passport
3. Student's updated Shot Records (MUST be stamped/signed by the doctor and all dates legible)
4. Parent / Guardian Driver's License or Photo ID
5. Proof of Residency (Lease Agreement, Gas, Water, Electric bill within 30 days of registration)

Transfer Option

- Parents may request a transfer within the designated window to another campus and will be considered after enrollment and eligibility is determined at the home campus.

- Important to Note:
 - Transfers are approved based on enrollment at the campus requested.
 - Transportation is not provided for students receiving a transfer.
 - Pre-K Transfers are only applicable for the Pre-K school year – parents must apply for a transfer if they want their child to remain at the campus upon entering Kindergarten.

General Information

Curriculum

The [Mansfield ISD PK Curriculum](#) is an integration of experience-based active explorative learning and the Texas Education Agency (TEA) Pre-Kindergarten Guidelines ([English](#) / [Spanish](#)).

The Texas Pre-Kindergarten Guidelines are based on current knowledge of theory and scientific research about how children develop and learn; they reflect the growing consensus among early childhood professional organizations that a greater emphasis be placed on young children’s conceptual learning, acquisition of basic skills, and participation in meaningful, relevant learning experiences. The guidelines delineate the behaviors and skills children are to exhibit and achieve and instructional strategies for teachers. The guidelines provide a means to align Pre-K programs with the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS).

Assessment / Progress Reports

During the first nine weeks, teachers will assess all students on Pre-K skills and objectives. A parent/teacher conference will be scheduled to discuss progress after the assessment is completed.

Attendance

It is very important that your child attends school regularly. Children make better progress when their attendance is consistent. The more consistent your child’s attendance is, the more opportunity your child has to develop age appropriate behavior and social contacts. If your child is absent, please call the campus or send a note upon his/her return to school to be considered an “excused” absence. Otherwise, it will be “unexcused.” Students enrolled in prekindergarten or kindergarten are required to attend school and are subject to the compulsory attendance requirements as long as they remain enrolled. A consistent morning routine allows students to arrive at school on time and ready to learn. Tardies interrupt classroom instruction and in many cases prevents your child from having a nutritious breakfast at school. Excessive tardies provide inconsistent routines for children and are highly discouraged.

Materials and School Supplies

Parents/Guardians will be responsible for providing the child’s backpack, a reusable water bottle, a clean towel (washed and returned weekly) to cover the nap mat, an extra set of clothing, and diapers, if the child is not potty trained. Parents are encouraged to label all materials and clothing with the child’s name.

Lunch

During lunch and snack times, students may also work on social skills, fine motor skills, and self-care. Parents/Guardians may provide lunch and snacks from home, or the student may purchase a school lunch. If a student has any allergies, please notify the classroom teacher and the school nurse.

Nap / Quiet Time / Rest

The Pre-Kindergarten daily schedule includes a downtime. Children this age need time to rest and rejuvenate their energy level so that they can concentrate and enjoy learning. A nap mat will be provided for each child. Parents will be asked to provide a blanket the size of a towel (washed and returned weekly) for the student's comfort. Due to safety and storage, please do not send additional items, such as a pillow or stuffed animals. Your child is not expected to take a nap, but s/he will be expected to lie on the nap mat quietly during downtime.

Health and Wellness

- The campus will have a registered nurse.
- The classroom staff will follow precautions when dealing with bodily fluids.
- If a student becomes seriously hurt or ill during the day all efforts will be made to contact the parent/guardian or person listed on the emergency contact list.
- Per district policy, students may not attend school if they have had a fever or vomiting within the past 24 hours.
- Students may return once they have been symptom-free and unmedicated for 24 hours.
- Students must be free of any communicable diseases in order to attend school.
- Medications will be dispensed according to the district guidelines.
- Students will need to adhere to all state vaccination requirements.

Out of School Time Programs

Mansfield ISD's before and after-school programs, [Out of School Time](#), provides rigorous activities, engaging enrichment and recreational opportunities that will allow students to explore their interests and discover their talents while supporting students' creative expression, socialization and community awareness. Most importantly, students are safe, comfortable and have fun through a variety of interactive activities.

Monday – Friday

AM / Before School – 7:00 a.m.–7:30 a.m.

PM / After School – 3:30 p.m.–6:30 p.m.

QUEST is a prepaid program. At the beginning of the school year, registration and a week's tuition is due the Friday before school begins or before the student's start date, whichever occurs first. For *subsequent weeks*, tuition is always due on Friday for the upcoming week.

The annual application fee is \$50 for one child and \$75 for a family each school term. Tuition is then paid on a weekly basis:

AM / Before School – \$30 per week

PM / After School – \$65 per week

Before & After Care – \$75 per week
